A. AGREEMENT WITH PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING CONSULTANTS, P.A. FOR DESIGN SERVICES AT THE FOUR MILE CREEK WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY. DISTRICT #5.

Mr. Jim Weber, P.E., Director, Sewer Operations and Maintenance, greeted the Commissioners and said, "I'm very pleased, today, at the number of people that showed up for the Sewer Agenda. Two or three people is about it, unless we've made them mad.

"In Item A we are requesting your approval of an agreement with Professional Engineering Consultants for design services for expansion of the Four Mile Creek Wastewater Treatment Facility. The cost of this design work will not exceed \$216,655.05 and is to be paid from cash on hand in the Plan Expansion Plan for Four Mile Creek. These funds were collected from within the Four Mile Creek district through impact fees on new development and none of the cost will be paid by the County at large.

"You have received a full report from us on this project at your November 25th meeting. I won't go into any further detail, unless you have some questions. If you have no questions, we would request youR approval of the recommended action."
