1. AGREEMENT WITH MID-KANSAS ENGINEERING CONSULTANTS, INC. FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION STAKING SERVICES FOR THE ROCKY CREEK ADDITION, PHASE 6; SANITARY SEWER PROJECT. DISTRICT #1.
