Wichita, Kansas – A former Wichita/Clearwater car dealer was ordered to pay more than double his original fines for not complying with the terms and conditions of a consent judgment he entered into with the Office of the District Attorney through his Consumer Protection Division in December of 2016.

Just before Christmas, Justin Blevins, and his company Blevins Auto Group LLC, entered into an agreement with the Office of the District Attorney to remedy over 20 used car sales. The District Attorney alleged that Blevins failed to disclose to 21 consumers that he could not provide legal title for the car they purchased. As part of the consent judgment Blevins waived any claim of ownership of the 21 vehicles and agreed to pay a fine, court costs, and investigative fees by January 27, 2017.

On Friday, June 23rd, Judge Warren Wilbert increased the fine after Blevins failed to make the court ordered payments.
