WICHITA, KAN. – A man has been sentenced to prison after being convicted by a District Court jury last month. On December 21st, Judge Kevin O'Connor sentenced Jordan Lewis, 40 of Wichita, to 330 months after being found guilty of two counts of aggravated criminal sodomy, two counts of aggravated indecent liberties with a child, criminal sodomy and possession of marijuana with intent to distribute.

On the night of November 4th, 2015, two runaway girls, 15 and 16 years old, were walking near 21st and Hydraulic when they were offered a ride by Lewis. Once in the car, the man pulled a gun and drove them to a house in the 2400 block of east Piatt where the girls were sexually assaulted by Lewis and another man. The 15 year old girl escaped the home the next morning and ran to a neighbor's house to get help. Lewis was arrested the next day.
