WICHITA, KAN. – A man who tried to carjack a woman at a west Wichita convenience store has been sentenced. District Judge Steve Ternes followed the Kansas sentencing guidelines and sentenced Julio Conde, 26 of Wichita, to 24 months of probation with an underlying prison sentence of 21 months.

Conde pled guilty last month to attempted robbery and two counts of misdemeanor battery.

On October 17th, Conde tried to steal a woman's car at the Quik Trip at 21st and Ridge Road. The 38 year old woman screamed. Conde backed up and walked away. A man in the Quik Trip followed Conde as he walked to the east. In the parking lot of Hurts Donuts on 21st, Conde charged the man and both started fighting. A second citizen arrived and both held Conde down while they waited for police to arrive. One of the two citizens was treated for bruises at a hospital.

Along with sentencing Conde to probation, Judge Ternes today ordered Conde to comply with all mental health treatment and recommendations.
