Wichita, Kansas - Four people were sentenced to prison in connection with the shooting death of a Wichita man. Martin Carlos-Decasas, 50 of Wichita, was shot once in the chest during a robbery in a home in the 2500 block of east Murdock in Wichita on September 8, 2016.

On July 6th, District Court Judge Joe Kisner sentenced Danny Williams Jr., 19 of Wichita, to 328 months in prison. Williams was convicted of 2nd degree (intentional) murder and aggravated robbery.

Ashley Evans, 22 of Wichita, was convicted of 2nd degree (reckless) murder and attempted aggravated robbery. Judge Kisner sentenced her to 123 months in prison.

Shaqwania Mathis, 20 of Wichita, was convicted of 2nd degree (intentional) murder and attempted aggravated robbery. She was sentenced to 155 months.

Evian Matias, 18 of Wichita, was convicted of 2nd degree (reckless) murder and attempted aggravated robbery. He was sentenced to 181 months in prison.
