Wichita, Kansas - A judge has sentenced a man to over 48 years in prison for kidnapping a teenage boy and sexually abusing him. Nicholas Miller, 37 of Wichita, pled no contest to an amended charge of aggravated kidnapping. The 15-year-old boy told Wichita Police Miller touched him sexually at Miller's Wichita home on August 9, 2014. Miller had told the boy he could repair his computer and asked him to bring it to his house.

On Thursday District Judge Warren Wilbert sentenced Miller to 586 months in prison. Miller's attorney had asked Judge Wilbert for a sentence of 155 months.
