Wichita, Kansas - A woman was sentenced to prison following multiple cases of shoplifting at stores in Wichita. Sarah Henning, 43 of Wichita, was sentenced to 14 months in prison by Sedgwick County District Judge David Kaufman on December 11th. Henning pled guilty to four of the five shoplifting cases against her in June, and was charged with a fifth case while awaiting sentencing on the previous four.

Henning admitted to shoplifting electronics, clothes, perfume and other items from Best Buys, Kohl's, Gordman's and JC Penney Stores in Wichita. The monetary value of the items is over \$3,640.

In her plea agreement, Henning can no longer enter the previously listed businesses anywhere in the United States.
