WICHITA, KAN. – A man has been sentenced to prison for shooting another man in the face after an apparent road rage incident. Jonathan Newcomb, 29 of Wichita, was sentenced to 59 months in prison on a charge of attempted 2nd degree murder. District Judge Christopher Magana also ordered Newcomb to pay over \$19,600 dollars in restitution with almost \$17,000 going to the Kansas Crime Victims Fund and the rest to the victim, Luis Leon-Olmos.

On August 13, 2014 Leon-Olmos and Newcomb confronted each other in a parking lot in the 1900 block of S. Seneca in Wichita. Newcomb was riding a bicycle while Leon-Olmos was the driver of a black pickup. Video surveillance showed Newcomb gesture toward the driver of the truck before both stopped in the parking lot. Words were exchanged before Newcomb pointed a 9mm semiautomatic pistol at Leon-Olmos and pulled the trigger. Newcomb was later arrested in the 2400 block of S. Seneca.

Newcomb pled guilty to attempted 2nd degree murder. Leon-Olmos lost his left eye in the attack.
