WICHITA, KAN. – A Sedgwick County District Court jury found Matthew Wimberly guilty of attempted 1st degree murder. Wimberly stabbed Andrew Langston twice, once in the neck and again in the head. The attack occurred at Wimberly’s home in the 3300 block of E. Victor in Wichita on September 22nd, 2013. Emergency personnel found the knife blade broken off in Langston’s skull. Langston spent several weeks in a hospital.

The jury in Judge Jeffrey Goering’s courtroom received the case Thursday afternoon and reached their guilty verdict Friday morning. A sentencing date has not been set.
