WICHITA, KAN. — On Wednesday, a man was sentenced to prison for stealing over \$50,000 from an elderly woman. Jeremy Glenn, 35 of Mulvane, pleaded no contest and was found guilty of felony theft and possession of methamphetamine. District Court Judge David Dahl sentenced Glenn to 37 months in prison.

Investigators for the District Attorney in conjunction with the Kansas Department of Children and Families Adult Protective Services and the Derby Police Department uncovered information that Glenn gained access to a disabled 75 year old Derby woman's investment account via checks and her ATM card. Glenn was accused of stealing money from the disabled woman after he offered to help her clean her home.

Judge Dahl ordered Glenn to repay over \$21,000 to the victim for losses from her ATM account and \$32,000 dollars to Morgan Stanley for funds taken from the victim's investment account.
