WICHITA, KAN. — A man pled guilty to involuntary manslaughter and aggravated battery in the traffic death of an 89 year old Wichita resident. Matthew Mabry, 35 of El Dorado, also pled guilty in a second case to 6 counts of burglary and 3 counts of theft before Sedgwick County District Judge Ben Burgess on August 1.

On June 24, 2013 a pickup driven by Mabry crossed the center line on Central at Dougherty in west Wichita and struck a lawn equipment trailer being pulled by a pickup, injuring the driver. The trailer struck an older model Plymouth driven by Arlene Root. Ms. Root died at the scene.

In the second case, Mabry stole 3 pickup trucks, a trailer and other items including a mountain bike and wheel lock sets from businesses on E. Kellogg in 2013.

Mabry is scheduled to be sentenced by Judge Burgess on August 29th.
