On the recommendation of Angee Sisco, on behalf of the Facilities Department, Linda Kizzire moved to accept the low bid from Snodgrass & Sons Construction in the amount of \$1,833,600.00. Sara Jantz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Services under this contract will include construction of a new fire station located 334 N Main, Haysville. The station will include four apparatus bays and living quarters for full time staff.
