WICHITA, KAN. – A man who seriously injured another person during a fraudulent Craigslist transaction was sentenced to 53 months in prison Thursday by a District Court judge.

Kyle Waymire, 22 of Wichita, had previously entered a guilty plea to aggravated battery for causing serious injuries to a 33-year-old Wichita man on July 9, 2017, in a QuikTrip parking lot at 1620 S. Webb Road.

The victim said he met Waymire in the parking lot to sell some electronic items that he had advertised for sale on the internet using a service called Craigslist. The victim said he suspected Waymire of paying for the items with counterfeit bills and Waymire struck the victim with his car when he attempted to flee the parking lot.

Judge Stephen Ternes also ordered Waymire to pay \$11,502.54 in restitution to the victim for his medical expenses.
