WICHITA, KAN. – A \$140,876.75 default judgment was entered against the owner of a now-closed Wichita car dealership, Quality Used Cars, LLC at 2759 S. Broadway.

The lawsuit, brought by the District Attorney against Quality Used Cars, LLC and its owner, Angelo Jefferson Anderson, alleged deceptive and unconscionable acts and practices involving car sales to ten consumers. Specifically the complaint alleged Quality failed to provide titles to customers and honor warranties. The judgment against Jefferson requires that he pay \$120,000 in civil penalties, \$20,679.75 in restitution, and costs and fees.

The District Attorney reminds residents that customers should also receive certificates of title within 60 days of any vehicle purchase. Otherwise, the transaction is void and customers are entitled to a full refund.

The default was granted February 7, 2019 by Judge William Woolley. The case was investigated by Scott Kelley, an investigator with the District Attorney's Office.
