WICHITA, KAN. – A man was sentenced to prison for the shooting death of man in south Wichita. Judge Steven Ternes sentenced Casimiro Nunez, 62 of Wichita, to life in prison with no parole eligibility for 50 years. Nunez was also sentenced this afternoon to 18 months for possession of methamphetamine with intent to distribute. Judge Ternes ordered both sentences to run concurrently.

Early the morning of October 29, 2016 Antonio Guzman was shot three times in a house in the 3100 block of S. Yale in Wichita.

In March of this year, a jury in Judge Ternes' courtroom found Nunez guilty of first degree murder along with the drug charge.
