**WICHITA, KAN.** – A woman was sentenced to prison for possession of methamphetamine with intent to distribute. Judge Dave Dahl sentenced Sonja May, 38 of Wichita, to 68 months. Wichita Police found the meth in May's purse during a traffic stop in the 1400 block of S. Seneca on July 29, 2017.

May was sentenced this morning during a video connection from the Sedgwick County Jail. On March 30th, prosecutors, defense attorneys, judges and court personnel began handling probation violations, first appearances, and sentencings by video connection. Prosecutors login from the DA Library on the second floor of the Sedgwick County Courthouse. Defendants are not taken to the Courthouse, and stay in the County Jail during these hearings. All jury trials and other hearings have been suspended until further notice from the Kansas Supreme Court.
