WICHITA, KAN. – A man was sentenced following a 2018 traffic death in south Wichita. District Judge David Dahl sentenced Monty Carpenter Jr., 36 of Wichita, to 76 months in prison. Last April, Carpenter pled guilty to involuntary manslaughter while in the commission of driving under the influence in the death of Marsha Oglesby. The 59 year old Wichita woman died in a two-car crash on September 3rd, 2018.

Carpenter's vehicle ran a red light at 31st Street S. and McLean Blvd and struck a vehicle driven by Ms. Oglesby. After the crash, Carpenter ran from the scene and crawled beneath a trailer. A Wichita police officer saw Carpenter and arrested him.

Along with the prison sentence Monday, Judge Dahl added 36 months of post release when Carpenter leaves prison and ordered him to pay \$7,654.58 in restitution. Carpenter will have to pay \$150 a month starting the second month after he is released.
