WICHITA, KAN. – A woman who pointed a handgun at two Wichita Police Officers has been sentenced to 57 months in prison. District Judge Eric Williams ordered Jennifer Miller, 35 of Wichita, to be transported to the Kansas Department of Corrections to serve her sentence.

On March 31st, a Wichita Police Officer found a stolen car in the parking lot of the Red Roof Inn at Kellogg and Armour. The officer observed a woman trying to open the trunk and then made contact with her. While the officer was making contact, Miller pulled a black handgun from her purse and pointed it him. She then aimed at a second officer who arrived and was standing a short distance away. The first officer fired a single shot from his service weapon and struck Miller.

On September 1st, Miller pled guilty to two counts of aggravated assault of a law enforcement officer.

Before sentencing Wednesday afternoon, Miller's attorney told Judge Williams his client was high on methamphetamine and heroin at the time of the incident.
