

DAYCARE GUIDANCE FOR ISOLATION

ABLE TO WEAR A MASK

- 5 days at home from symptom onset or test date (no symptoms) with that date as Day 0
- If fever-free 24 hours without fever reducing medication and symptoms are gone or mostly gone, 5 additional days wearing a well-fitting mask at all times around others but can return to daycare

DAYCARE GUIDANCE FOR QUARANTINE

For any of the below scenarios, if the close contact develops symptoms, they should stay home and be tested.

ABLE TO WEAR A MASK

- 5 days at home from last exposure (Day 0), plus an additional 5 days wearing a well-fitting mask at all times around others

UNABLE TO WEAR A MASK

- 10 days at home from last exposure (Day 0)

HOUSEHOLD CONTACT

- 10 days of case's infectious period plus 5 days at home, then an additional 5 days wearing a mask (or 10 days if unable to wear a mask)

Day 0 Last Exposure	Day 1 Case's infectious period begins	Day 2	Day 3	Day 4	Day 5	Day 6
Day 7	Day 8	Day 9	Day 10 Case's infectious period ends	Day 11 Contact remains home	Day 12	Day 13
Day 14	Day 15	Day 16 Return to daycare and wear mask around others	Day 17	Day 18	Day 19	Day 20
Day 21 If unable to wear mask, remain in quarantine until Day 21
