- During the month of June, Sedgwick County Developmental Disability Organization (SCDDO) Quality Assurance Staff completed 4 day and 10 residential program visits.
- Work with the affiliated providers related to COVID – 19 was ongoing throughout June as we shared information, best practices and resources. Affiliates continued to submit Safe Start Transition Plans. The plans outline the practices and procedures affiliates have implemented to safely provide services in the current environment with COVID – 19. The COVID – 19 Affiliate Directors meeting switched to bi-weekly. In June these meetings included information on the CARES Act funding, critical incident data and Safe Start Transition Plans.
- SCDDO Management Team participated in the Open Minds I/DD Executive Summit June 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>. The summit was a virtual event designed to expose management staff to paradigm-shifting new ideas to leverage market trends, scale innovation, and gather tools and skills to build a long-term plan for sustainability.
