Russell Leeds: How soon is this going to start?

Lynn Packer: This work will not begin until the end of May. This bridge is located right in front of Clearwater High School and in order to avoid creating a traffic issue, the construction needs to be done during the summer months.

Russell Leeds: Anything special about this bridge otherwise?

Lynn Packer: Nothing for us. It's a standard project. Our biggest concern with this overall is it's a very small project at just half a million dollars and obviously summer is prime construction season so obtaining and keeping a contractor on this project during prime construction for just a small project was a big concern. We are very pleased with the bid results and is much better than we anticipated.
