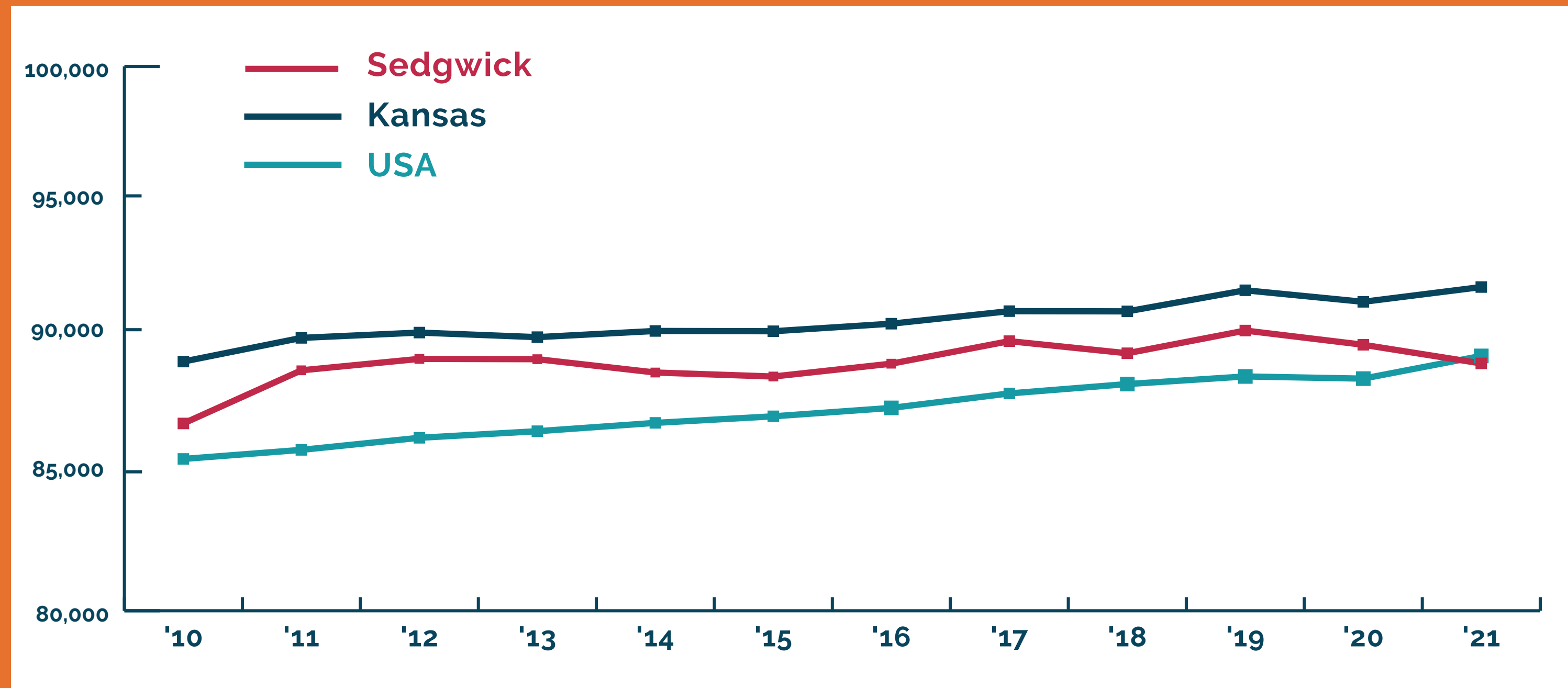

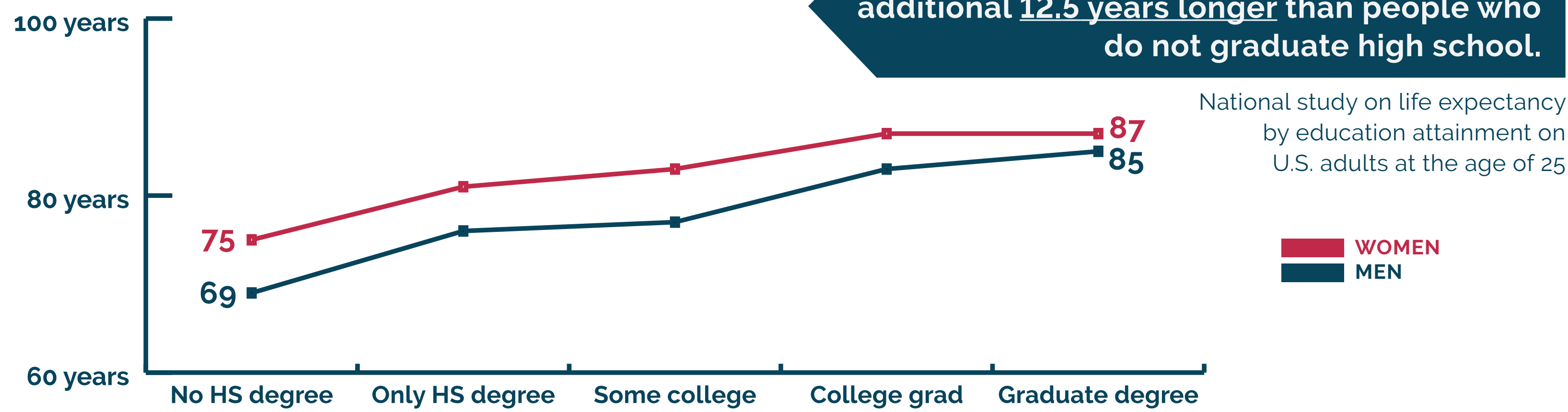

Public schools have a lack of funding for special classes like music, books are out dated, history not properly taught. Kids are the future and need to invest better.

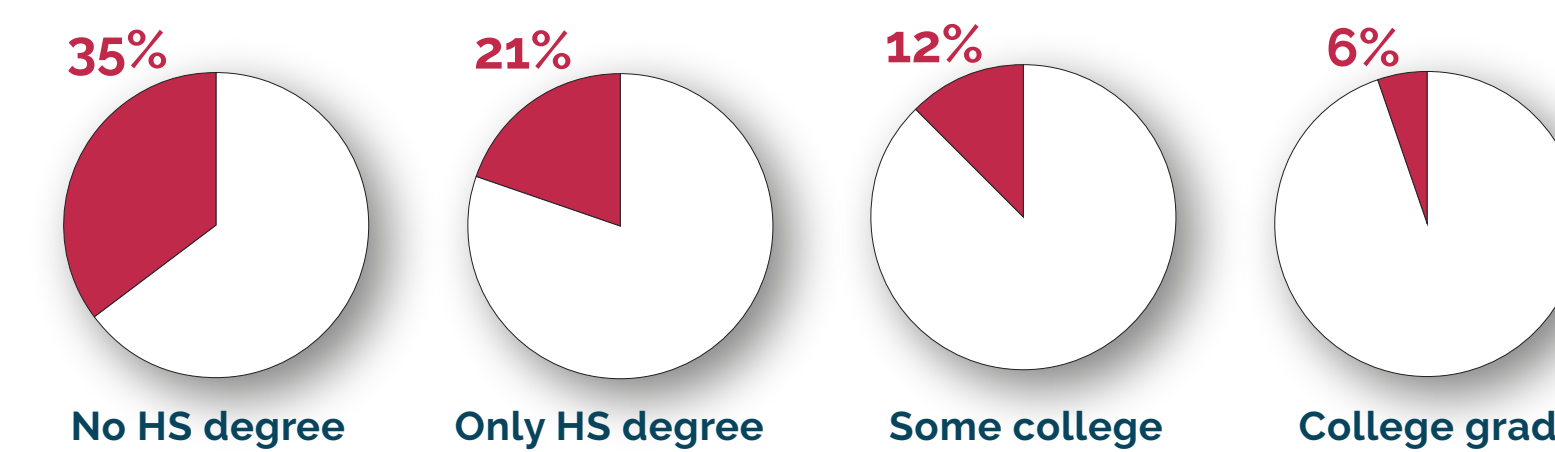

Percentage of Sedgwick County residents ages 26-64 without health insurance by education level.



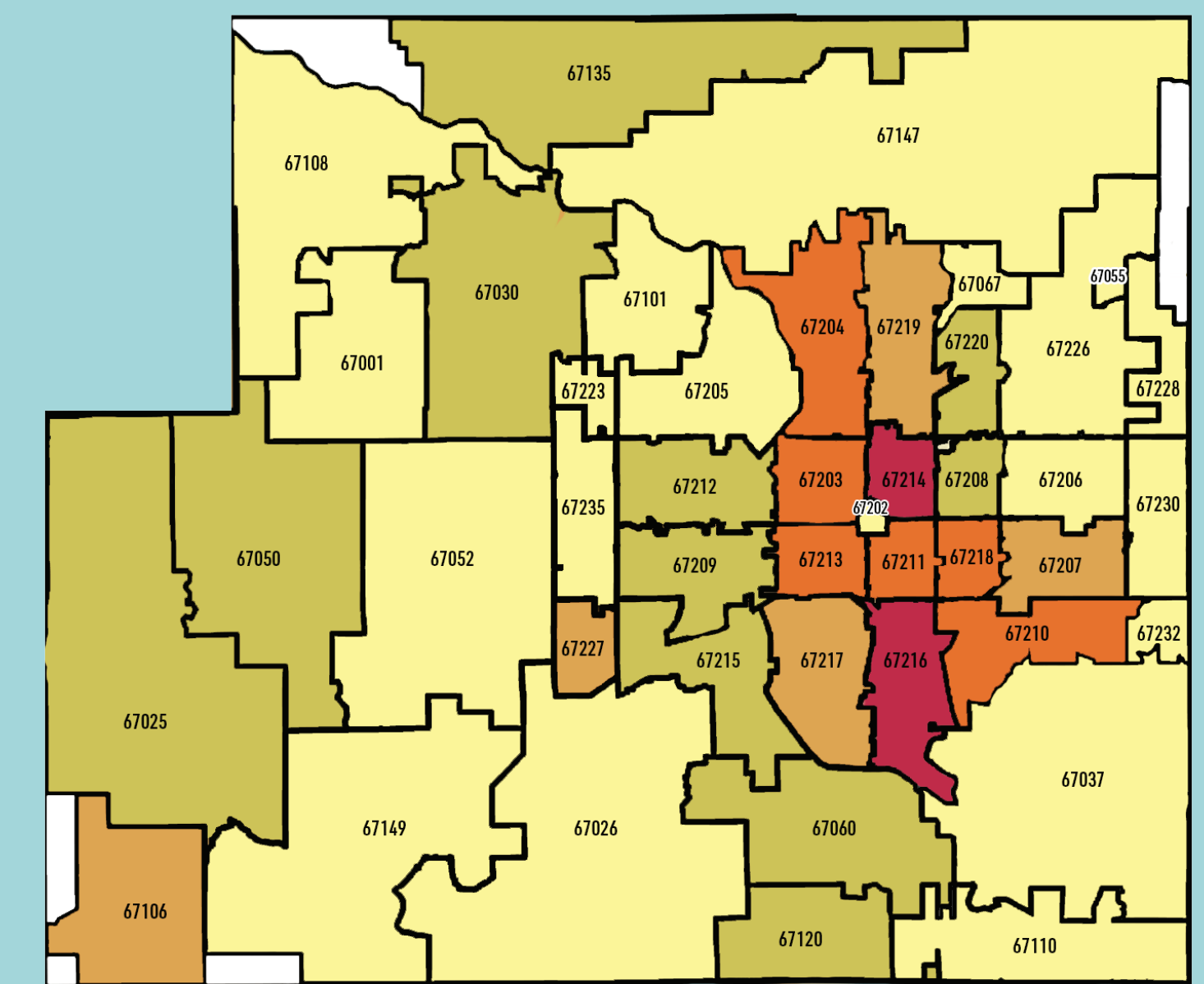

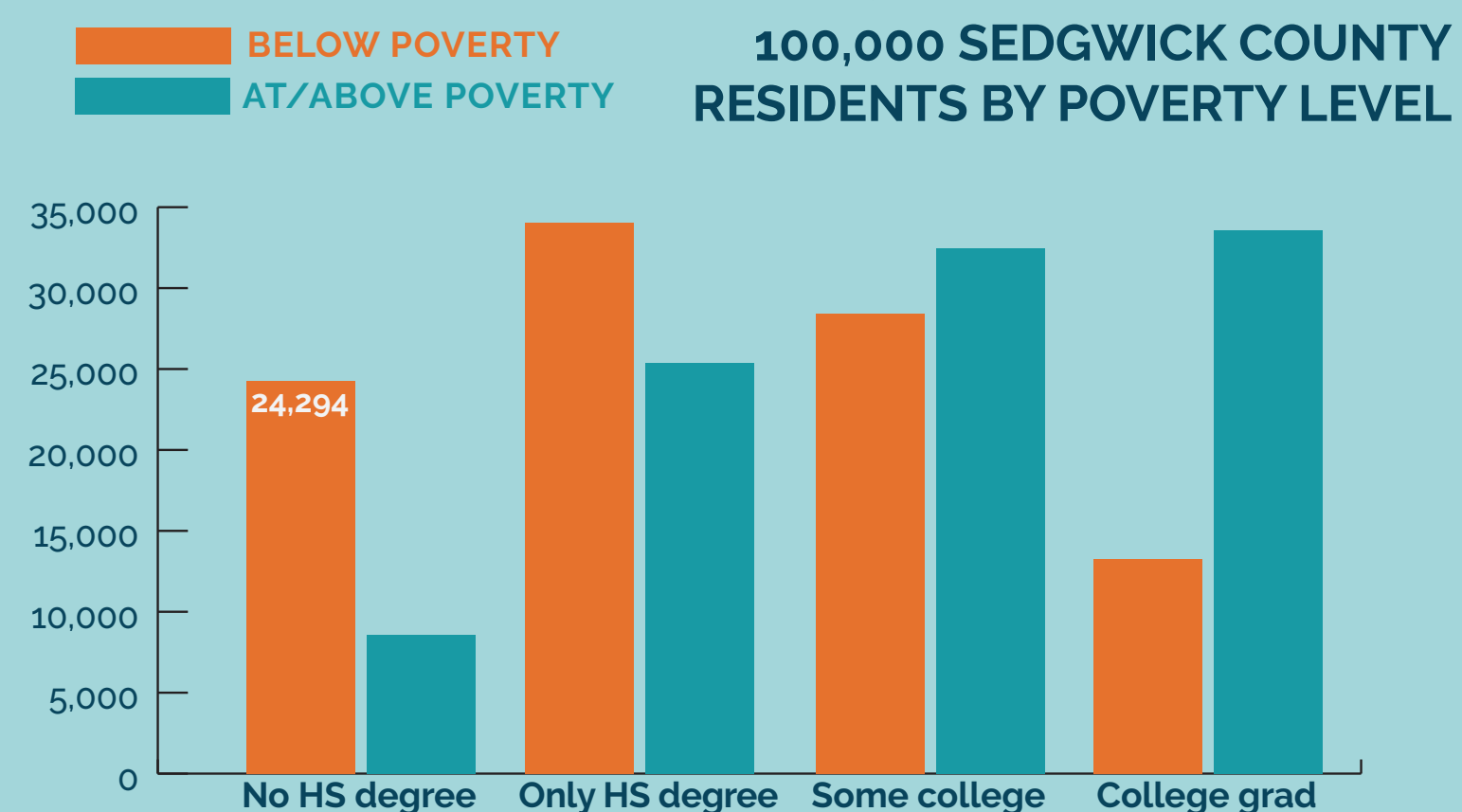

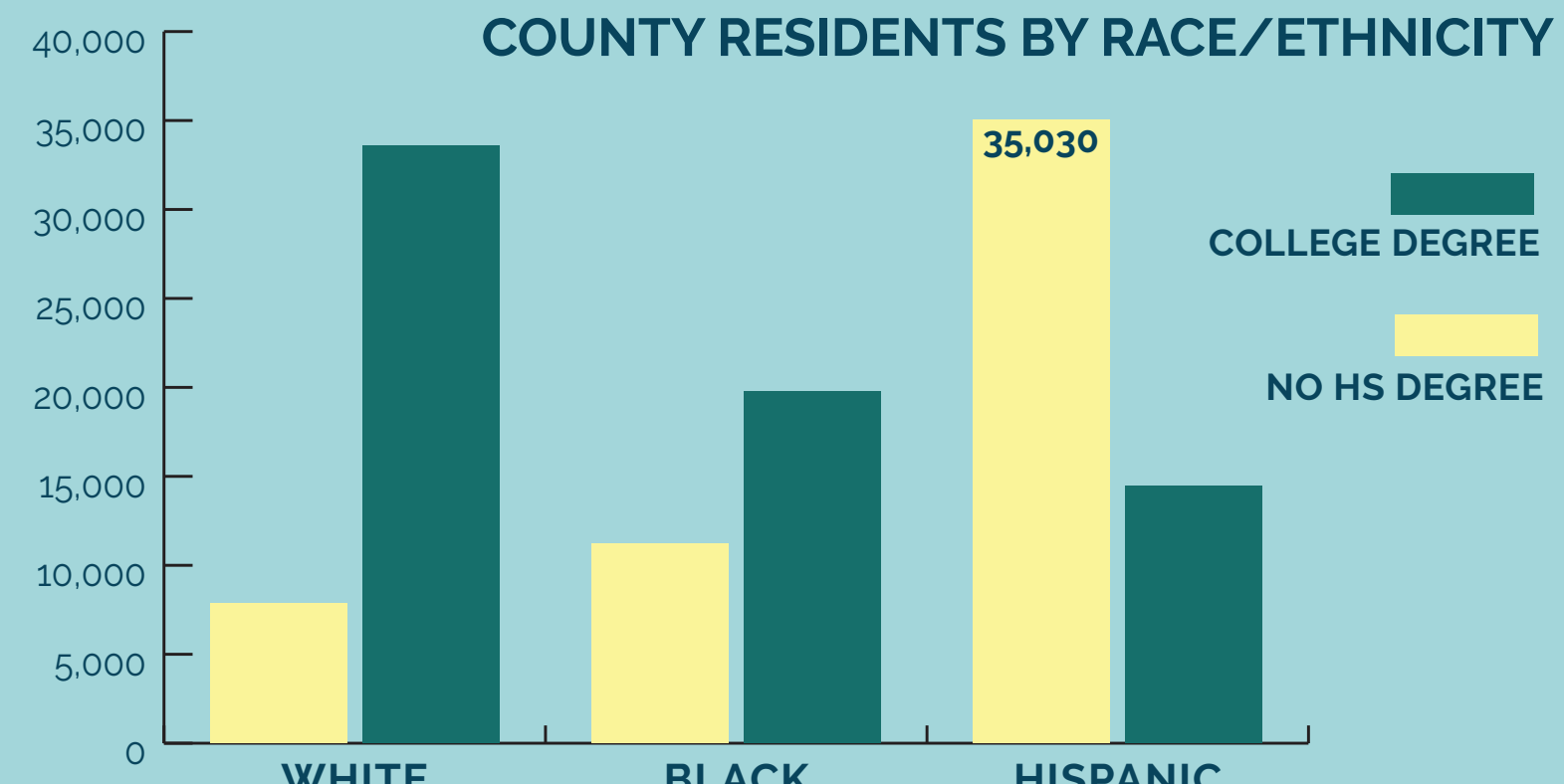
EDUCATION LEVEL RATE PER 100,000 SEDGWICK COUNTY RESIDENTS BY POVERTY LEVEL

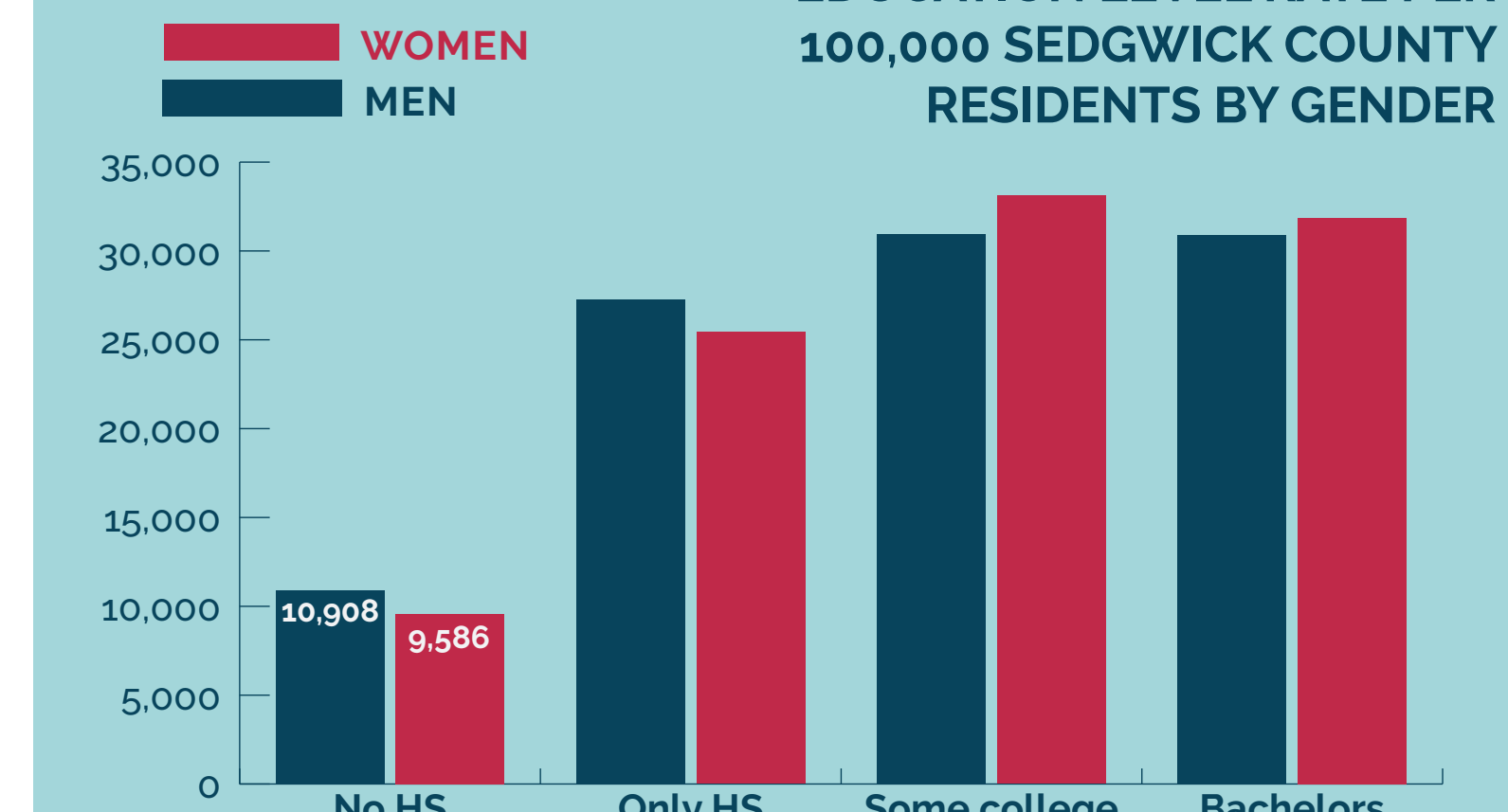
EDUCATION LEVEL RATE PER 100,000 SEDGWICK COUNTY RESIDENTS BY RACE/ETHNICITY
