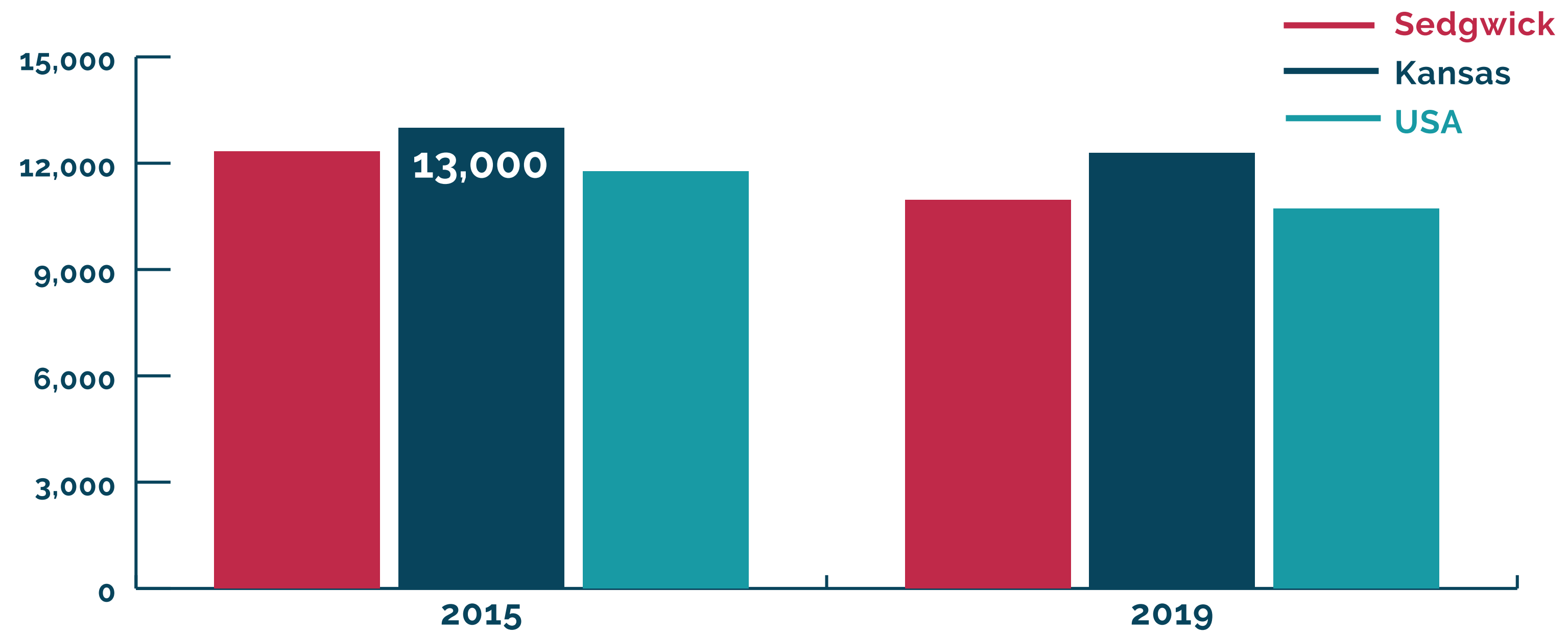

AVERAGE LIFE EXPECTANCY AMONG PEOPLE REPORTING FOOD INSECURITY IN CANADA

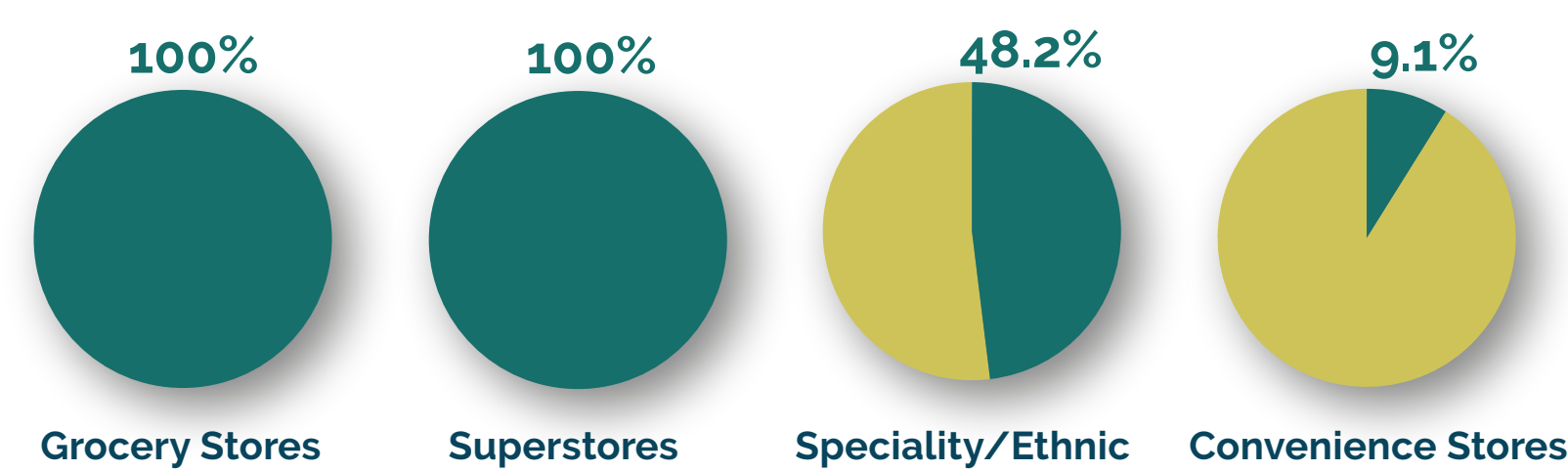

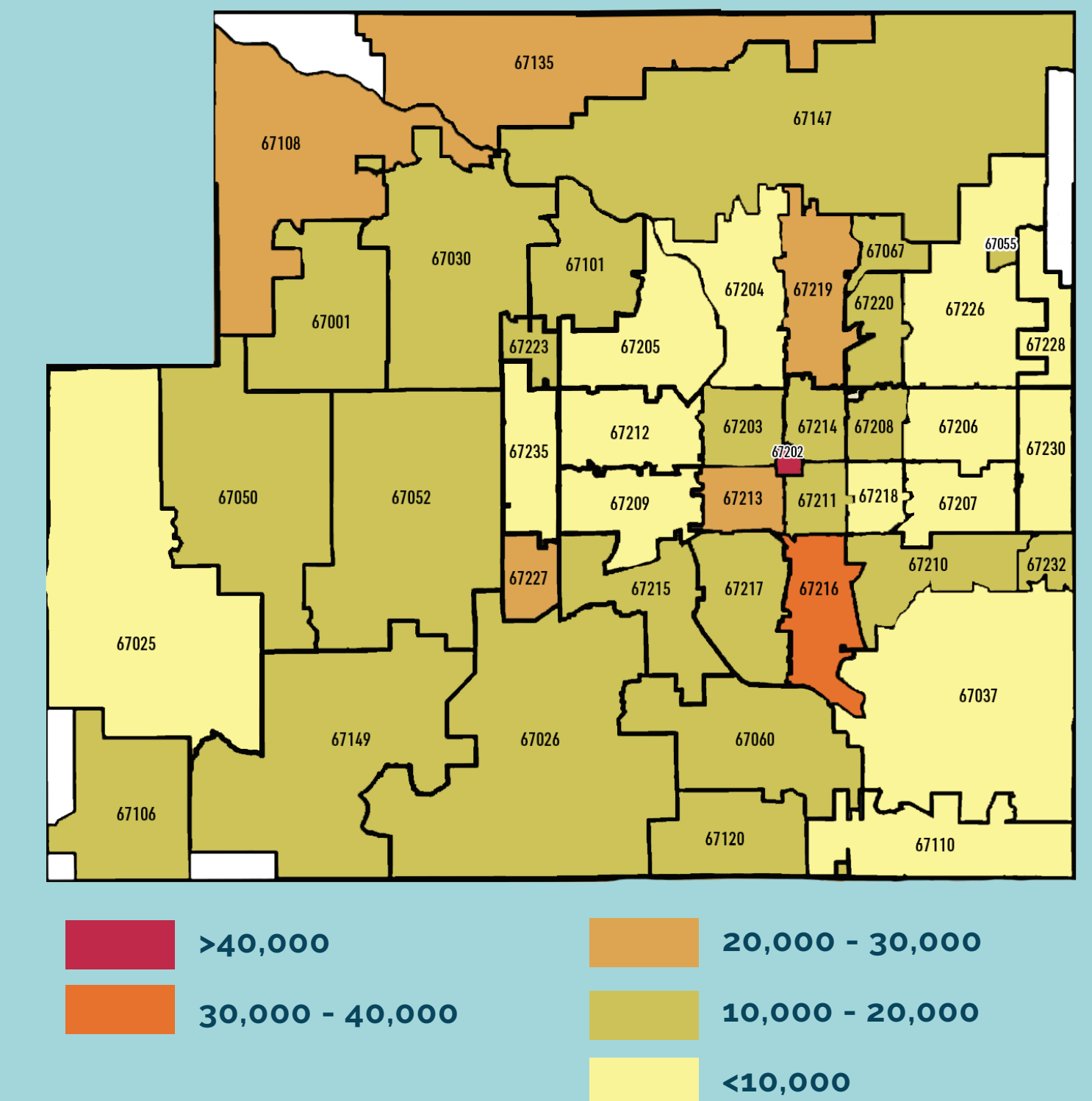

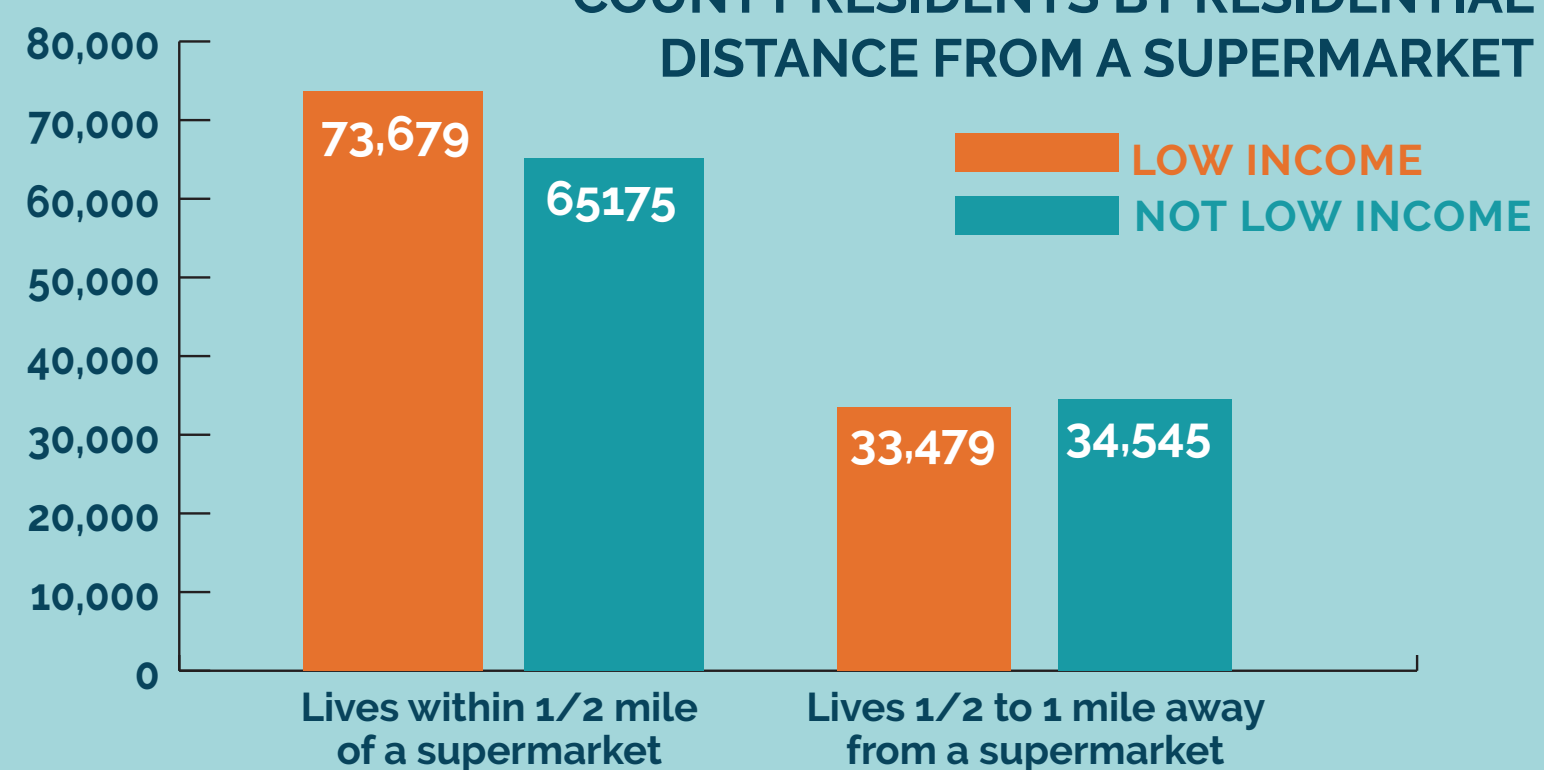

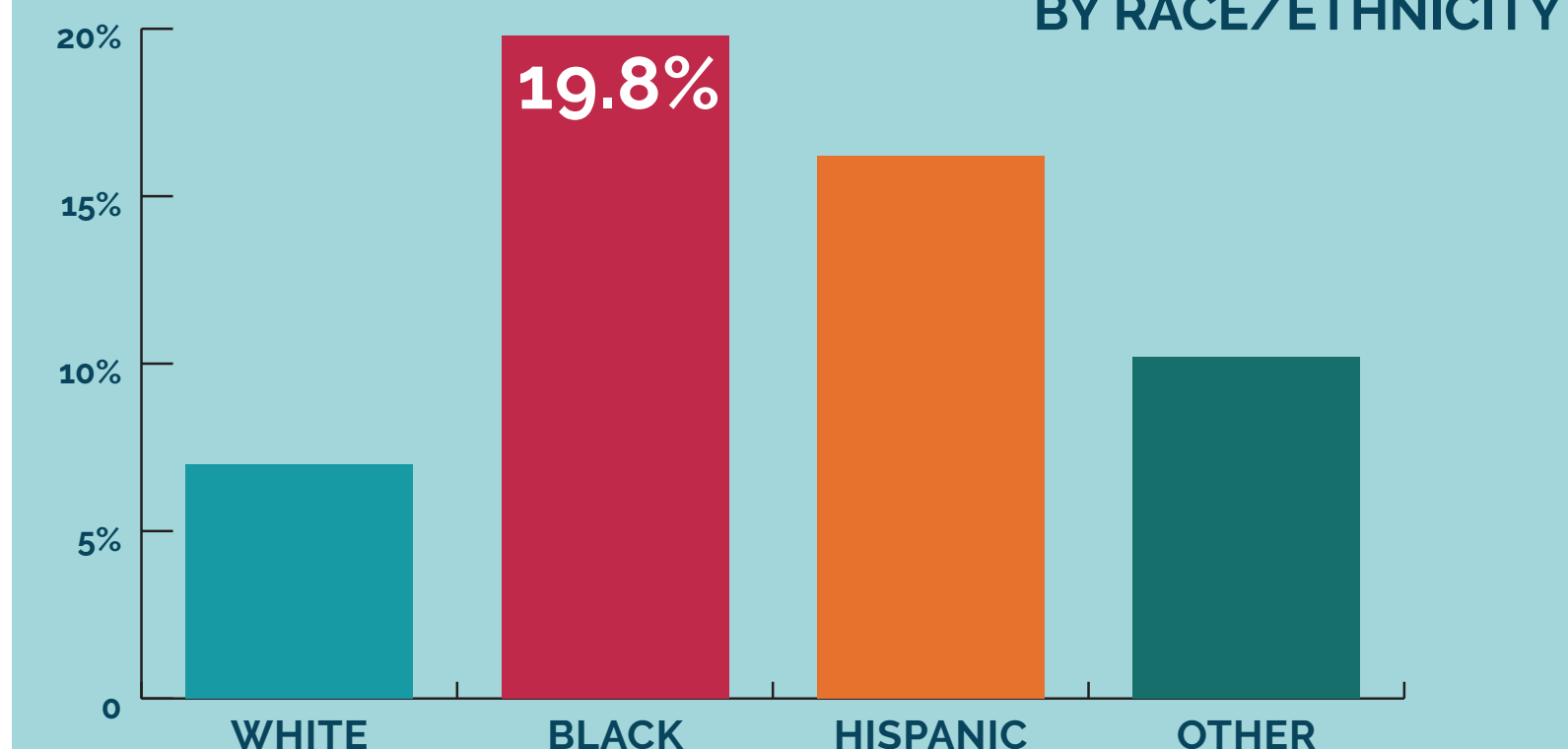
RATE PER 100,000 SEDGWICK COUNTY RESIDENTS BY RESIDENTIAL DISTANCE FROM A SUPERMARKET

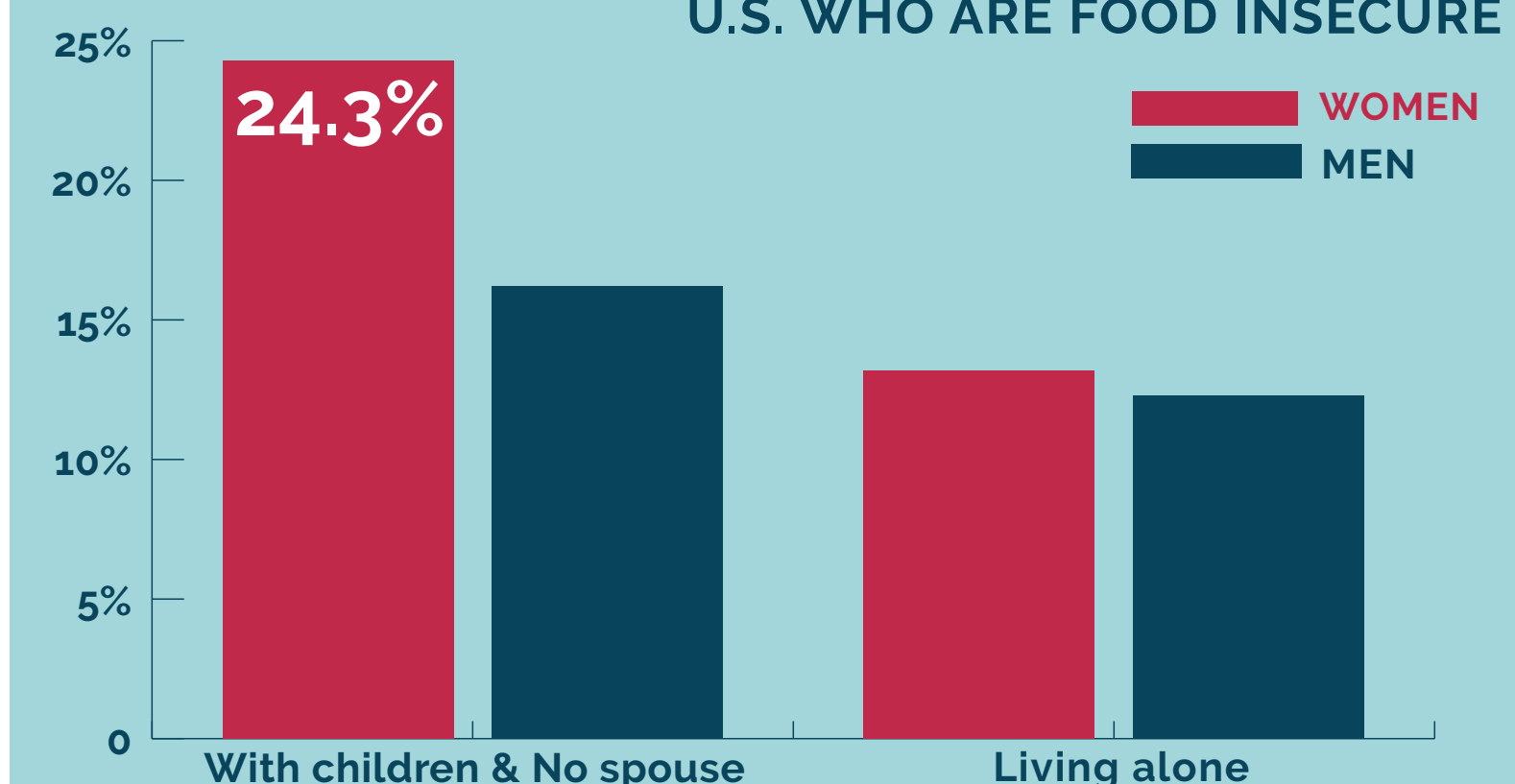
PERCENTAGE OF U.S. RESIDENTS WHO ARE FOOD INSECURE BY RACE/ETHNICITY
