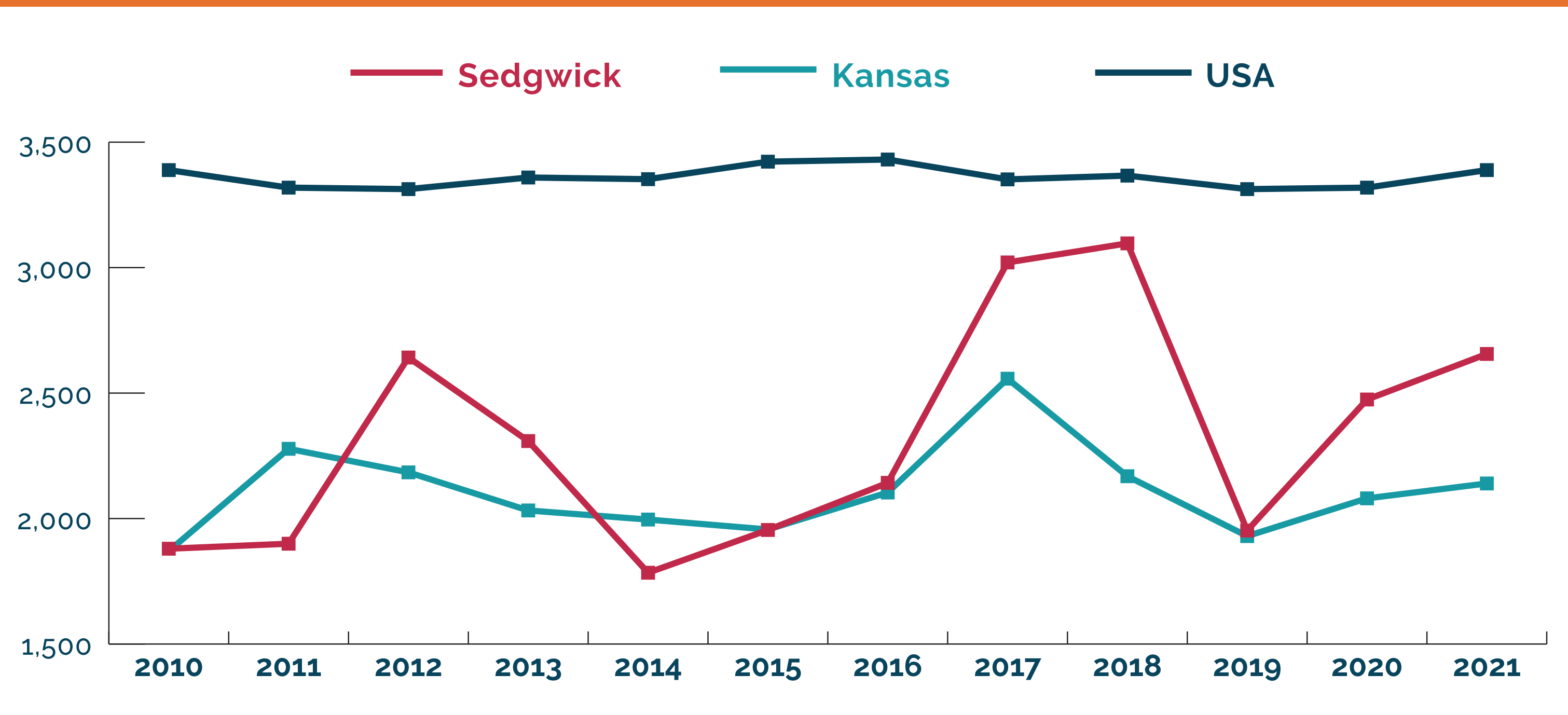

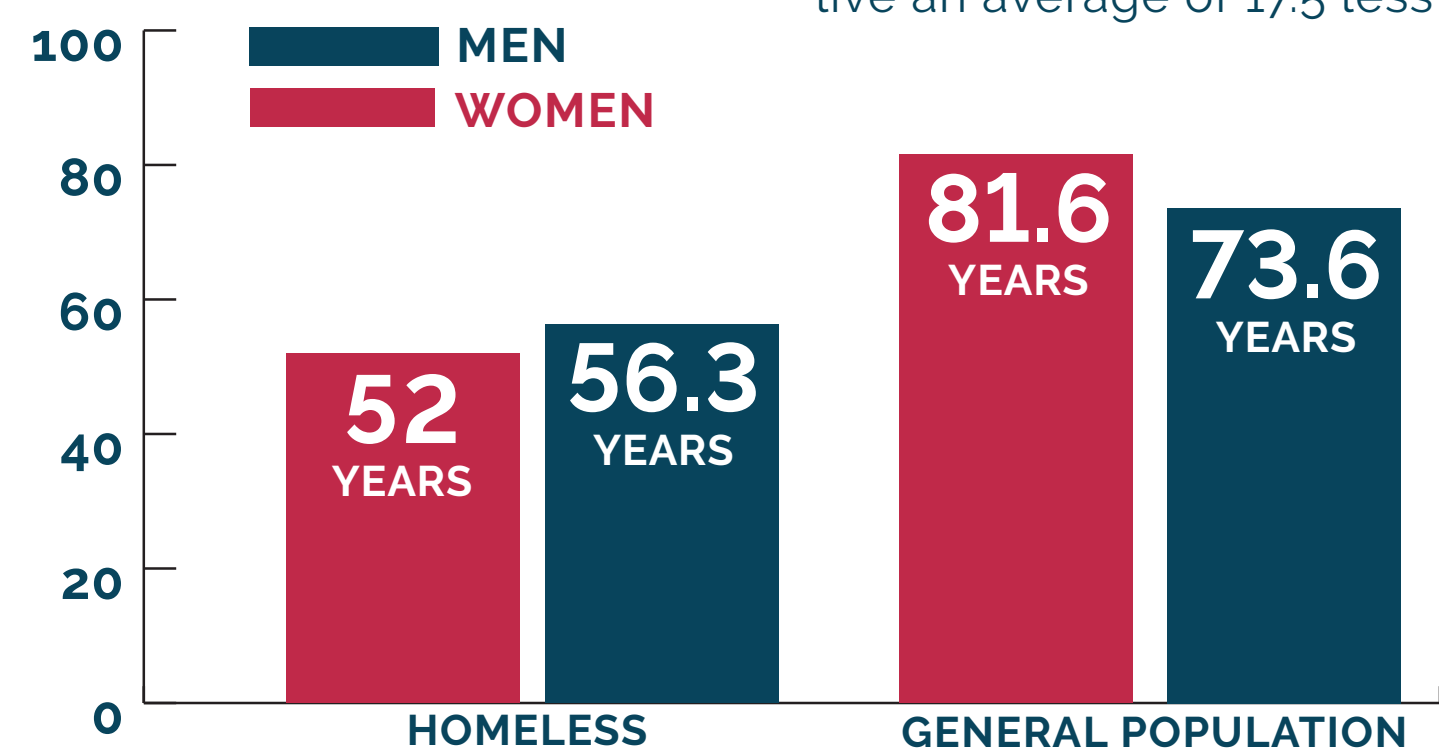

One study showed people who are homeless live an average of 17.5 less years

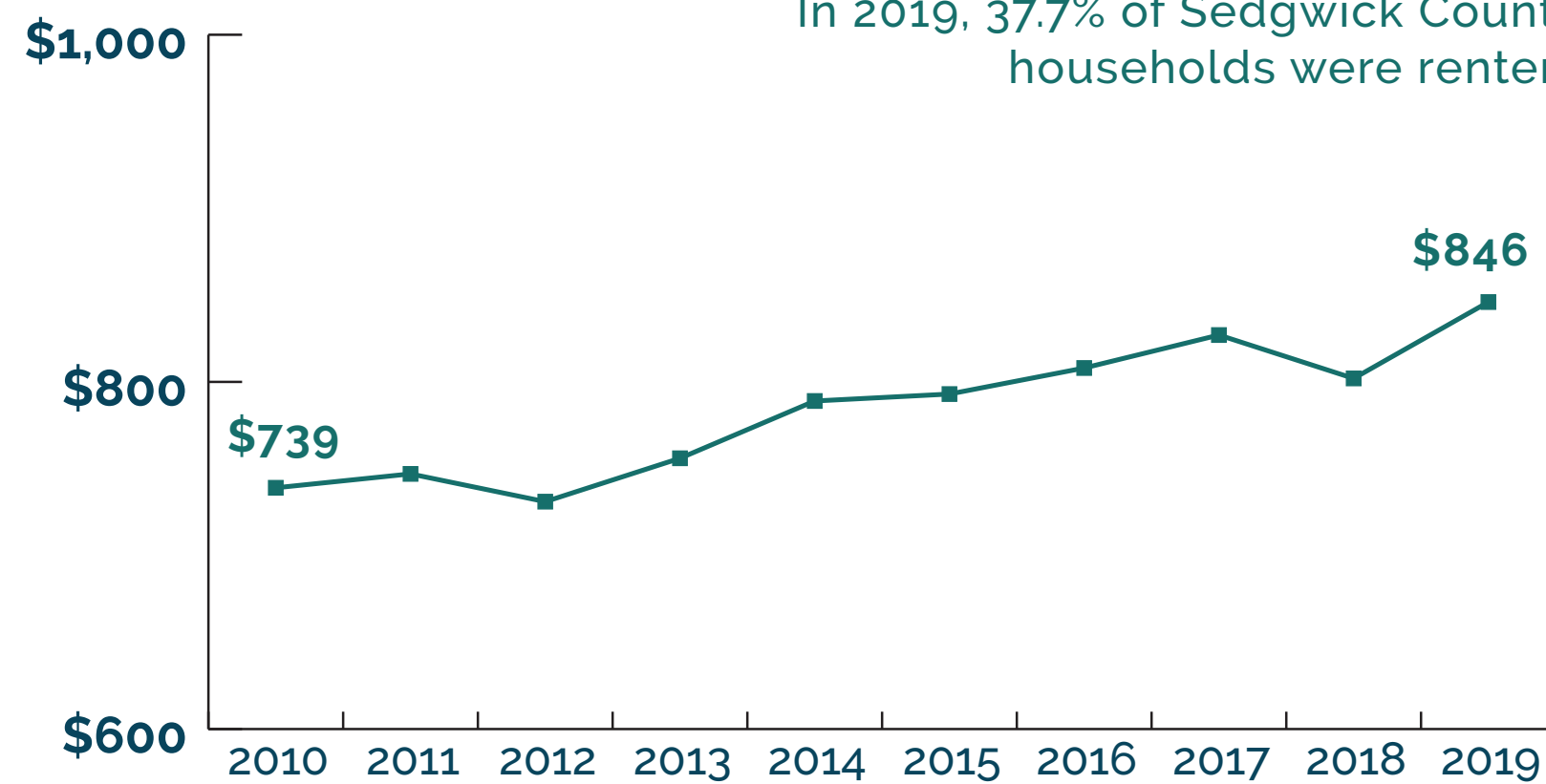

In 2019, 37.7% of Sedgwick County households were renters

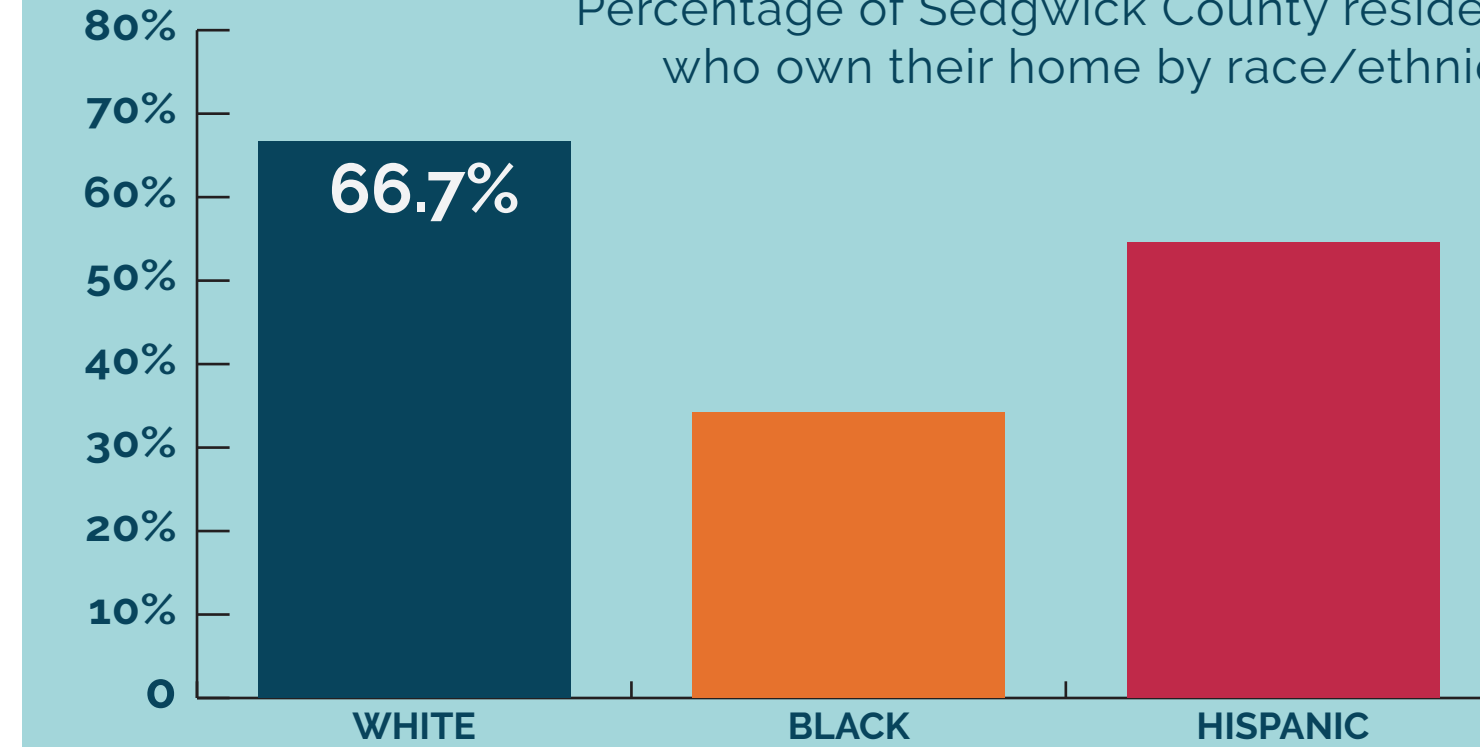

Percentage of Sedgwick County residents who own their home by race/ethnicity



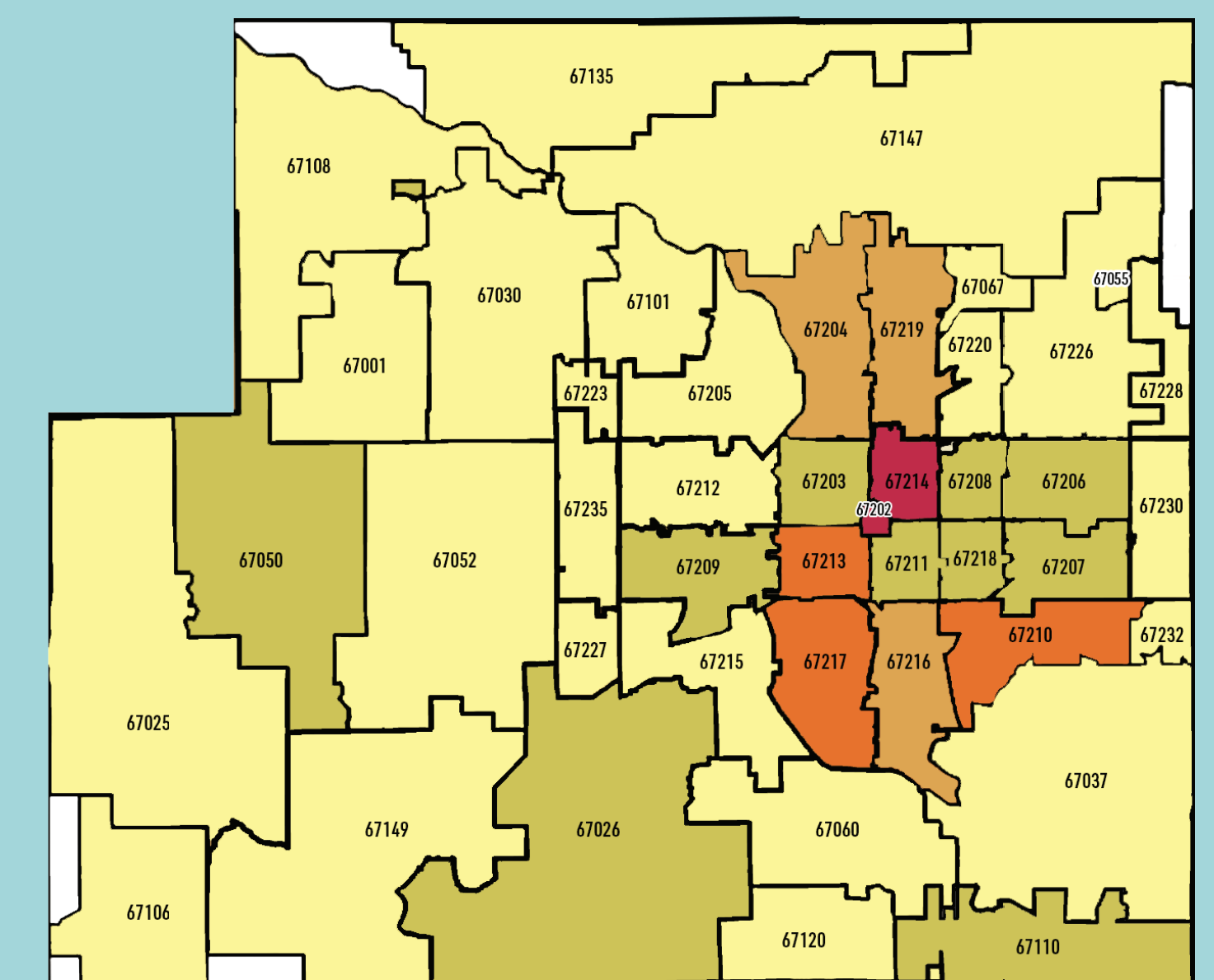

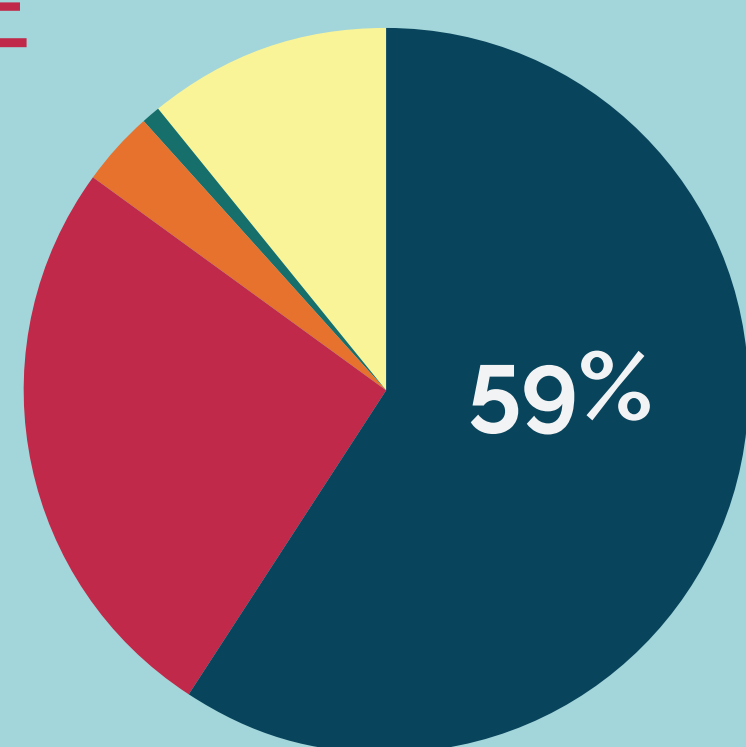

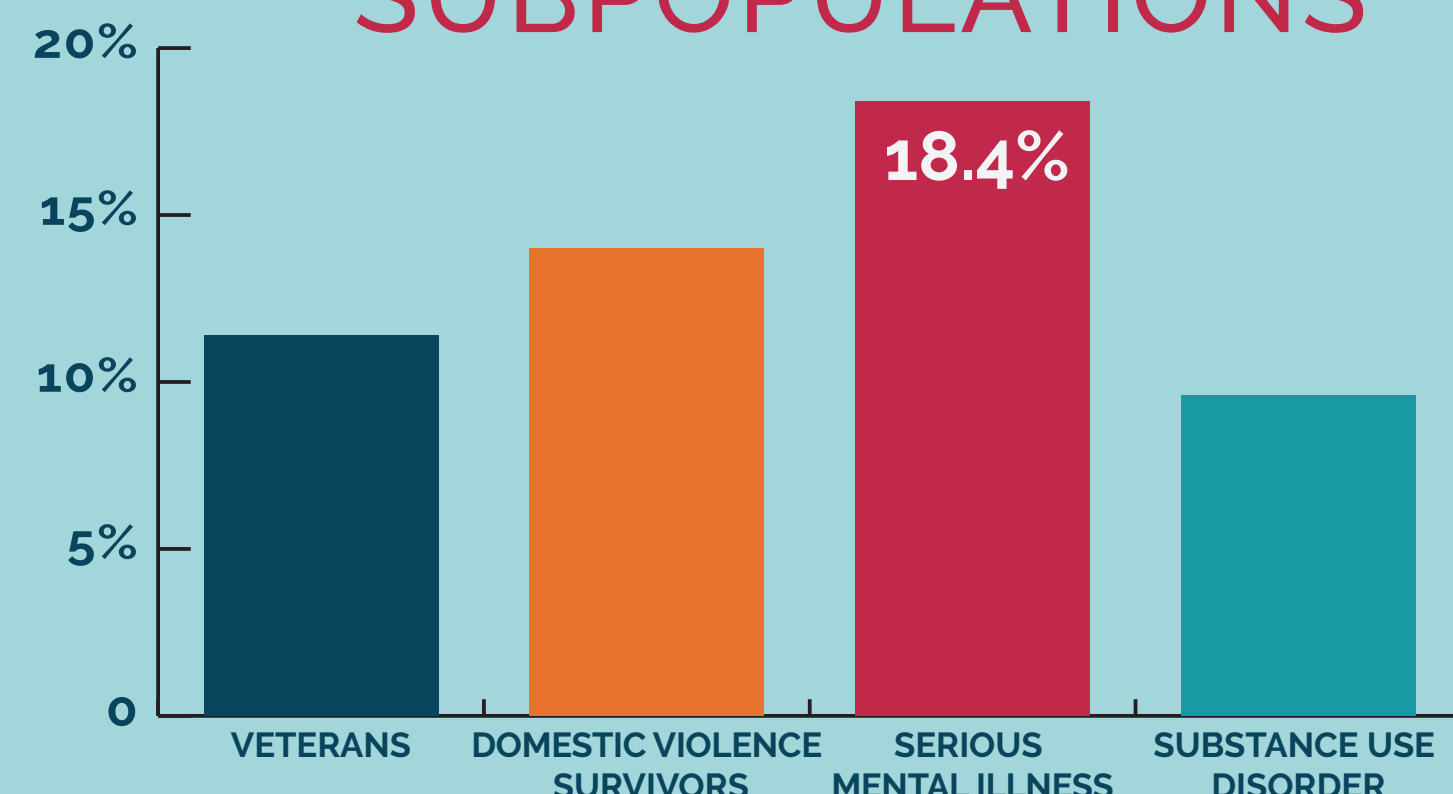

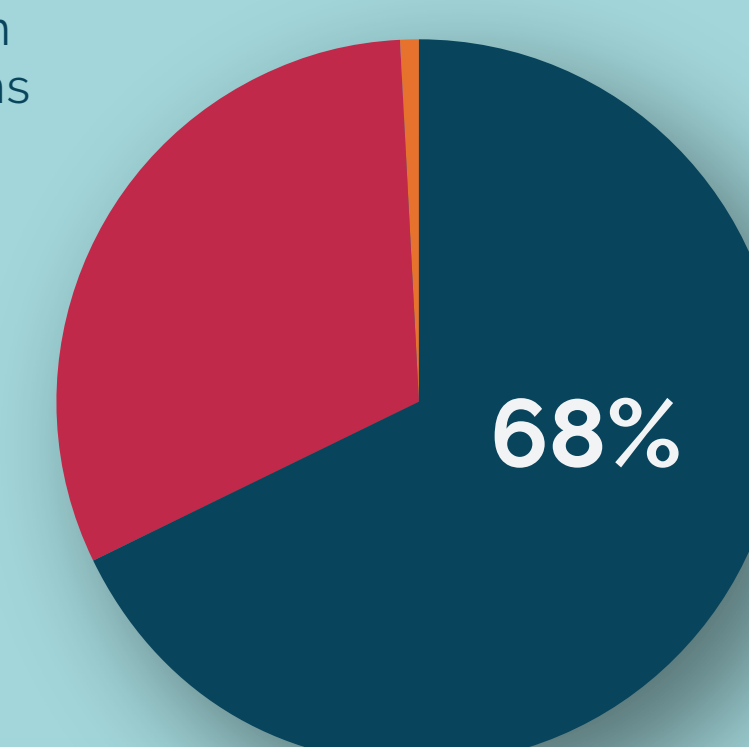
