The following is to ensure that vendors have complete information prior to submitting a proposal. Here are some clarifications regarding the bid for Dead Deer Collection for Sedgwick County Health Department - Animal Control.

Questions and/or statements of clarification are in **bold** font, and answers to specific questions are *italicized*.

1. How much does the current contractor get paid?

2. Where would anyone dispose of dead deer and/or livestock?

Plum Thicket Landfill in Harper, Kansas and the Wichita Animal Shelter are the only two (2) places Animal Control knows of that accept large animals like that. Pricing is unknown.

3. How many deer do you request pick up of a year?

The total spend during the previous four year contract period was \$19,343.25. Based on this, the annual average number of deer collection would be a little over 46. However, that number can vary by year and season due to rut, car wrecks, hunting, etc.

Firms interested in submitting a *proposal*, must respond with complete information and **deliver on or before 1:45 pm** *CST*, *February 14, 2023*. Late *proposals* will not be accepted and will not receive consideration for final award.
