On the recommendation of Joe Thomas, on behalf of Emergency Medical Services, Jennifer Dombaugh moved to **accept the lowest and best proposal from Physio-Control, Inc. in the amount of \$1,053,154.70 and establish contract pricing for three (3) years.** Tim Kaufman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

A committee comprised of Scott Hadley - EMS Director, Dennis Mauk - EMS Deputy Director, Dr. Sabina Braithwaite - Medical Director of the Wichita/Sedgwick County Emergency Medical System, Dalene Deck - EMS Education Division leader, Paul Misasi - EMS Quality Improvement Manager, Charles Fair - EMS IT Support Specialist, Paul Gibson - EMS Logistics Manager, Dave Johnston - EMS Operations Manager and Joe Thomas - Purchasing, evaluated proposals based on proposed services, data analysis, functionality, training offered, warranty and qualifications of proposers. The committee shortlisted three proposers for further review and interviews: ZOLL Medical Corp., Physio-Control, Inc. and Philips Healthcare a Division of Philips Electronics North America. Physio-Control, Inc. was selected based on our comprehensive assessment and subsequent evaluation scoring.

The county will be able to reduce their costs even further by selecting Physio-Control, Inc., because there are several accessories that are compatible with our current monitor/defibrillator (Physio-Control LP-12) and the new LP-15. In addition, we may not need to purchase 100 AED units because we have LP-1000 AEDs in the system already and operationally the LP-15 is very similar to our current LP-12. Training costs and time will also be reduced due to compatibility of existing and proposed systems.

On the recommendation of Kimberly Evans, on behalf of the Facilities Department, Tim Kaufman moved to **accept the low bid from DanCo Enterprises, Inc. in the amount of \$143,500.00.** Jennifer Dombaugh seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

This project will provide Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) improvements at Lake Afton Park located in Goddard, KS. This project is on the ADA transition plan and will address the medium priorities such as a new ADA accessible fishing dock with an accessible route from the parking space to the dock and shelter on the west side of the park. The project also addresses thresholds at entrances into two existing shelter houses and ADA accessible paths to the new ADA accessible picnic/grilling areas. Campsites are also included in the improvements. All upgrades will comply with the Recreational Facilities Specifications and Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG) specifications and all were designed to meet the 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design.
