Hours worked **must be with or for a nonprofit 501(c) (3) agency**. If you have questions regarding a prospective opportunity contact the Diversion Office. It is your responsibility to ensure that community service verification forms are accurately filled out, completed at an approved nonprofit organization and returned to the Diversion Office.

What is a Nonprofit 501(c) (3) Organization?

Being a nonprofit organization means that the agency provides a social service to the community and only makes enough money to cover the costs of staying in business and they are tax exempt.

Section 501(c) (3) is: the portion of the US Internal Revenue Code that allows for federal tax exemption of nonprofit organizations, specifically those that are considered public charities, private foundations or private operating foundations. It is regulated and administered by the US Department of Treasury through the IRS.
