## Notice of Funding Eligibility

August 2020

### Who does this impact?

Individuals who have had a functional assessment will receive a document, which advises the individual of their funding eligibility and tier score.

*Important Note:* This document is not a confirmation of funding or an offer of funding. It is strictly for informational purposes regarding eligibility for the funding source.

### What is the Functional Assessment (AKA BASIS)?

The functional assessment is an assessment that collects information on everything from name and address to medical conditions and support needs. This tool is used to determine eligibility for ICF/MR level of care and eligibility for HCBS Waiver Funding.

### What is a Tier?

The functional assessment generates 3 scores, one for each functional ability area which are then combined to produce a converted score. A converted score of 35 or greater is needed in order to meet the ICF/MR level of care criteria and HCBS Waiver Funding eligibility requirements.

The higher the tier the greater the level of support need. Tier 1 being the highest tier and tier 5 being the lowest tier.

Tier 0, score less than 35, is an unfunded tier and would not be eligible for ICF level of care or HCBS funding.

### What should I look for?

- Whenever a person receives an assessment for the first time, a Notice of Action will be generated by KDADS, explaining that the person either is, or is not eligible for ICF/MR services or HCBS funding.
- When a re-evaluation is done, which results in the person no longer being eligible for ICF/MR services or HCBS funding, a Notice of Action is generated by KDADS to that effect.
- When a re-evaluation is done and the person continues to be eligible and has HCBS/IDD funding a Re-Evaluation Notice is generated.
- SCDDO will send a copy of these forms to the individual and/or guardian and to the Targeted Case Manager (TCM).

### Notice of Funding Eligibility

#### **Important Notes:**

If you receive notice you have been determined not eligible for HCBS/IDD Program services, please note this WILL NOT impact your eligibility for the I/DD service system. The notice only applies to your eligibility for HCBS I/DD waiver funds if an individual currently receives waiver services, for services to continue alternative funding will need to be located.

All individuals, currently receiving HCBS/IDD Program funds who become a tier 0 will receive an automatic functional assessment review by SCDDO staff.
