The vaccine testing was rushed.

The vaccine is not safe.

It will change my DNA.

Getting the vaccine can give me COVID-19.

It contains egg proteins.

It causes serious side effects.

It will cause infertility.

FACT:

Medical experts have performed the necessary studies in tens of thousands of participants showing the vaccines to be safe and effective.

A system is in place for doctors and the public to report any adverse effects. Medical experts are constantly reviewing reports to ensure safety.

According to the CDC, COVID-19 vaccines do not affect or interact with our DNA in any way.

The vaccine does not contain any live virus and cannot give you COVID-19.

There are no egg proteins and the vaccine can be given to people with allergies.

Most side effects are mild and are gone within a few days.

There is no evidence that the COVID-19 vaccine causes infertility.
