**EMERGENCY VEHICLE PERMITS
APPLICANT INFORMATION**

\$20.00 Application Fee. License expires three (3) years from date license is issued.

*Applicants applying for a permit of type 5 or 6 (see application) **MUST** attach proof of insurance with coverage limits as set forth in Sedgwick County Resolution 44-04, Section 26-142(c).

REQUIRED APPROVALS:

Wreckers Must have the approval of the sheriff of Sedgwick County or sheriff's authorized representative.

Civil Defense or Emergency Preparedness vehicles must have the approval of the sheriff of Sedgwick County or his authorized representative.

Emergency vehicles operated by *Public Utilities* must have the approval of the sheriff of Sedgwick County or his authorized representative.

Volunteer or other *Firefighters* using their personal vehicles in answering emergency calls shall have the approval of the chief of the fire department, the chief of police or the city marshal of the city maintaining the fire department; provided, however, the application of the *Chief of the Fire Department* shall have the approval of the chief of police or the city marshal and the sheriff; and a *Firefighter* belonging to or employed by a township, district or volunteer fire department need only have the approval of the chief of the department; the chief of the township, district or volunteer fire department and the chief of the township, district or volunteer fire department need only have the approval of the sheriff or his authorized representative.

Privately-Operated Ambulances shall be licensed in Kansas and shall have the approval of the chief of police or city marshal of the city in which the ambulance is housed, and the sheriff or his authorized representative; and any ambulance housed outside the corporate limits of a city need only the approval of the sheriff or his authorized representative. In addition, should the municipality where the ambulance is housed require said ambulance to be licensed pursuant to an ordinance or resolution, the emergency vehicle permit shall be contingent upon the licensing of said ambulance pursuant to the appropriate ordinance or resolution.

The application of *Police Officers or Law Enforcement Officers* for the designation of their privately-owned vehicles as emergency vehicles shall have the approval of the chief of police of the police department in which they are employed. An application of a deputy or assistant city marshal shall be approved by the marshal of the city in which the deputy or assistant city marshal is employed. The application of the undersheriff and deputy sheriffs shall be approved by the sheriff. The application of the sheriff to have the sheriff's privately-owned vehicles designated as emergency vehicles need only be signed by the sheriff and need not be approved by the other county or city officials.

The application of an *Officer or Employee of the State* shall have the approval of the head of the department or agency that has law enforcement authority in which the officer or employee of the state is employed.

An application for *Any Other Vehicle as provided in county code sec. 26-142(b)(6)* shall have the approval of the chief of police or city marshal of the city in which the applicant resides or maintains an office or place of business or is employed, and the approval of the sheriff or his designated representative; but if said applicant resides outside the corporate limits of a city in this county and is not employed within the corporate limits of a city in this county, the applicant need only be approved by the sheriff of the county in which applicant resides, maintains an office or place of business or is employed.
