Figure 1. Map of Ten Highest ZIP Codes by Rates of Spoken Language other than English in Sedgwick County

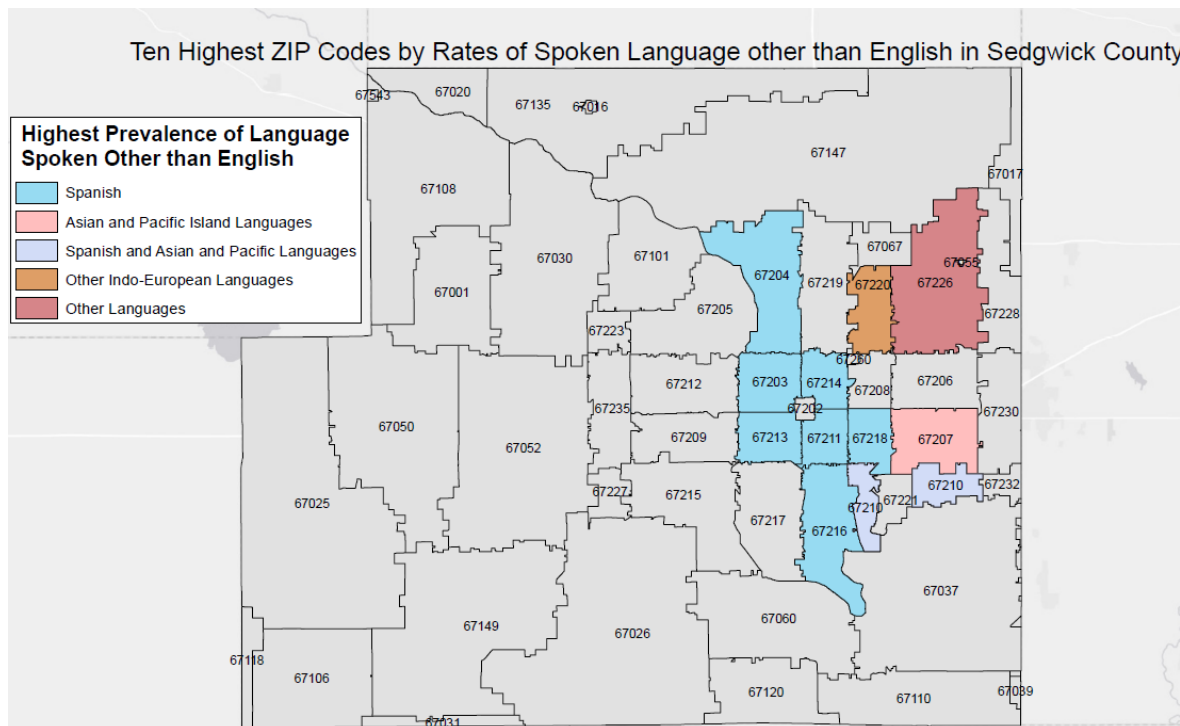
