2010 Personal Property Renditions

How many property renditions are mailed?

Approximately 46,000 personal property renditions will be sent out for 2010.

When will the property renditions be mailed?

The 2010 value notices will arrive in mailboxes beginning January 2, 2010.

Who should file a property rendition?

Anyone who owns taxable personal property in Sedgwick County as of January 1, 2010, should file a rendition with the Appraiser's Office.

Those affected include business owners or individuals owning personal items, such as aircraft, boats, trailers, non-highway vehicles or manufactured homes. Individuals who purchased new personal property before January 1, 2010, also should file a rendition with the Appraiser's Office.

Who will receive a property rendition?

Renditions are being mailed to those whose property is currently listed on the appraisal roll. If a rendition does not arrive in the mail, one can be requested by calling the Sedgwick County Call Center at (316) 660-9110 or by e-mail on the appraiser's Web page at www.sedgwickcounty.org.

What is the process to file a rendition?

Property owners need to verify information for accuracy, check the appropriate certification box, and sign and submit their filing to the Appraiser's Office. Unsigned renditions cannot be accepted and will be returned for signature.

What is the deadline to file a rendition?

The deadline for filing personal property renditions is March 15, 2010, and the deadline for filing oil and gas renditions is April 1, 2010.

Filing the rendition on or before the appropriate deadline will prevent late filing penalties of up to 50 percent.

Is there an online option to file?

Personal property owners also can access and update their accounts online at www.sedgwickcounty.org.

On the appraiser's page, click on the "**I-File Internet Personal Property Filing**" link and go to the "**Enroll Here**" link to instantly access your account information.
