

MEETING UPDATE

January 16, 2008

Below is a brief overview of the Sedgwick County Commission Meeting for January 16, 2008. You may find the agenda and streaming video on our Web site at www.sedgwickcounty.org.

Commissioners approved the Contract and Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding with the Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks. This contract allows public fishing access at Lake Afton and Sedgwick County Park for three years beginning January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2010. Sedgwick County will be paid \$45,051 per year from the Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks. (5-0)

Public Works

Commissioners adopted a resolution designating and classifying certain streets to the township system in District # 4. (5-0)

Commissioners approved an agreement with the Kansas Department of Transportation for a bridge replacement on Central between 375th St. W. and 391st St. W. (\$1,034,295) Project 618-2-4100. (5-0)

Commissioners approved an agreement with the Kansas Department of Transportation for a bridge replacement on Central between 71st St. S. between 295th Street West and 311th Street West. (\$2,336,127.84) Project 636-7-1973. (5-0)
