

MEETING UPDATE

January 30, 2008

Below is a brief overview of the Sedgwick County Commission Meeting for January 30, 2008. You may find the agenda and streaming video on our Web site at www.sedgwickcounty.org.

Appointments (5-0)

- Commissioner Parks appointed Jerry Davidson to the Wichita/Sedgwick County Access Advisory board.
- Commissioners appointed 12 members to the Sedgwick County Stormwater Management Committee.
- Commissioners approved the Second Class Cities nomination of Randy Parker to be reappointed to the Sedgwick County Solid Waste Management Committee with a term expiring December 31, 2009.
- Commissioners approved the Second Class Cities nomination of Kathy Sexton to be appointed to the Solid Waste Management Committee with a term expiring December 31, 2009.

Award

Commissioners approved the Safety Slogan "Count on Safety Because Someone is County on You" and awarded George Worman - DIO, Facilities Maintenance with a framed safety poster and other safety/health related items as winner of the 2008 Safety Slogan Contest. (5-0)

Health Department

Commissioners heard the Annual Report from the Sedgwick County Wellness Committee. There are 15 committee members, 387 employee members; 24 educational classes were held, with 383 employees attending in 2007. (5-0)

COMCARE

- Commissioners accepted the donation of new clothing items from www.opinionsrfun.com valued at \$1,300 to COMCARE's Homeless Program. (5-0)
- Commissioners approved an Agreement with Sumner Mental Health Center (MHC) for COMCARE to provide after hours mental health emergency services. Sumner County agrees to reimburse COMCARE \$100.00 administrative fee per month plus \$1.00 per minute of actual phone usage and \$1.00 per minute for time spent by COMCARE's Master Level Mental Health Professional. (5-0)

Public Works

- Commissioners approved the modification of fleet inventory to change the class of a ¾-ton truck to a one-ton truck. (\$3,447) (5-0)
- Commissioners approved an Agreement with the City of Wichita for the LIDAR Mapping Project to complete a levee certification for the Wichita-Valley Center Flood Control Project. Sedgwick County's share of the project is \$458,262 which will be reduced by funding from the USGS in the amount of \$73,023 for a local share of \$385,239. (5-0)
- Commissioners approved an Agreement with the City of Wichita for the Levee Accreditation Project to provide Sedgwick County with two years to complete the accreditation process. (Sedgwick County share \$1,200,000). (5-0)

Executive Session Announcements (5-0)

- Commissioners approved two workers compensation settlements -- Joe Baughman, \$31,863.41 leaving review/modification open for future medical payments and Richard Robbins, \$21,431.62, leaving review/modification open for future medical payments.
