February 27, 2008

Appointment

Commissioners appointed Terrell Black to the Sedgwick County Stormwater Management Advisory Board. (5-0)

Citizen Inquiry

Commissioners heard from Wichita citizen Jim Nichols regarding the Ark Valley Floodway. (5-0)

Public Works

Commissioners approved a resolution creating a road benefit district in Sedgwick County and authorizing improvements (Prairie Breeze Estates Addition). (Total cost - \$175,809). (5-0)

Planning Department

- Commissioners approved the Ashton Creek Park Commercial and Residential Community Unit Plan and county Zone Change from Single Family Residential to Limited Commercial, General Office, Neighborhood Retail and Multi-Family Residential; located at the intersection of 29th Street North and 199th Street West. (5-0)
- Commissioners approved a zone change from Single Family residential to Limited Commercial, generally located at the corner of 21st Street North and 159th Street East. (5-0)

Presentations

- Commissioners heard an update regarding addressing oral health needs in Sedgwick County. (5-0)
- Commissioners heard the Sedgwick County Appraiser's Annual Report of real property value trends in Sedgwick County. (5-0)

New Business

Commissioners approved an Amendment to the Agreement with KPTS to provide closed captioning services beginning March. (Total cost - \$18,450). (5-0)

Kansas Coliseum

Commissioners approved an Agreement with TB of America, Inc. for leasing of space for ticket stock and indoor advertising. (One year agreement for revenue of \$20,000). (5-0)

Department on Aging

- Commissioners approved a Contract for FY2008 with Halstead Home Health Care, LLC. to provide in-home care. (5-0)
- Commissioners approved an Agreement with Wichita Festivals, Inc. for the sponsorship of a Riverfest 2008 Senior Gala event. (\$1,500) (5-0)
- Commissioners approved five Agreements for FY2008 Targeted Case Management Services. (Medicaid funding) (5-0)

COMCARE

- Commissioners approved an Amendment to the Contract with Urban League of Kansas to provide group and individual psychosocial rehabilitation and attendant care services. (Total cost - \$125,000). (5-0)
- Commissioners approved an Agreement with South Central Mental Health Counseling Center, Inc. for COMCARE to provide after hours mental health emergency services. (5-0)

Fire District

- Commissioners received a donation in the amount of \$500 from the Dillons Store #16, 8828 W. 13th Street. (5-0)

Executive Session

Commissioners approved on worker's compensation settlement—Lanna Simpson, \$34,818.30 and closed out all issues.
