

MEETING UPDATE

March 19, 2008

Below is a brief overview of the Sedgwick County Commission Meeting for March 19, 2008. You may find the agenda and streaming video on our Web site at www.sedgwickcounty.org.

Off-Agenda Item:

Commissioners discussed the receipt of a letter from the US Department of Interior regarding land held by the Wyandotte Nation in Park City. The Commissioners authorized the Chairman to send a letter to the Bureau of Indian Affairs responding to specific questions related to property taxes, assessments and zoning for the land. The land has been owned by the Wyandotte Nation since 1992 and is located just south of the Wichita Greyhound Park. (4-0)

Emergency Communications

Commissioners approved an Agreement with the Kansas Department of Transportation for use of space to house a regional traffic management center. (4-0)

Division of Finance

Commissioners approved a contract with the Kansas Department of Social & Rehabilitation Services for operation and finance of the Exploited and Missing Children's Unit. (County share \$44,856.00 - other portions funded by SRS and City of Wichita). (4-0)

COMCARE

- Commissioners approved an Agreement with Wichita Child Guidance Center for COMCARE to provide professional psychiatry & supervision services. (Revenue: \$20,280). (4-0)
- Commissioners approved an Agreement with University of Kansas Center for Research, Inc. for an Interdisciplinary Team for youth with mental health needs involved with the Juvenile Justice System. (\$30,000) (4-0)

Kansas Coliseum

- Commissioners approved a Ticketing Agreement with Wichita Pro Sports for Select-a-Seat to provide ticket services for the Wichita Wingnut Baseball team at Lawrence-Dumont Stadium in exchange for a fee per ticket plus credit card fees. (4-0)
- Commissioners heard the Kansas Coliseum Monthly Report for February 2008. (4-0)
