Retirement

Presentation of retirement clock to Steven Hillman, Fire Lieutenant, Fire District #1 after 24 years of service. (5-0)

Economic Development

Commissioners conducted a public hearing and approved a resolution for terms and conditions for ad valorem tax exemptions to Huskerhawk Leasing, LLC. (5-0)

Planning Department

Commissioners denied an application for conditional use for a wireless communication facility on property zoned RR rural residential. (3-2)

Eaton Place

Commissioners adopted a resolution approving the City of Wichita corrective action to approve the 100% 15-year period of neighborhood revitalization area program rebates for the Eaton Place Commercial Condominium. (4-0)

COMCARE

Commissioners approved an agreement with Wichita Children's Home (WCH) to develop a collaborative project to provide mental health services for seriously emotionally disturbed children residing at WCH. (5-0)

Public Works

Commissioners approved a contract with Ruggles and Bohm, P.A. for design of Linden Street in Prairie Breeze Estates addition. (5-0)
