

MEETING UPDATE

November 28, 2007

Below is a brief overview of the Sedgwick County Commission Meeting for November 28, 2007. You may find the agenda and streaming video on our Web site at www.sedgwickcounty.org.

Public Hearing regarding whether Park City has provided services as set out in annexation plans

- Landowners requested that the annexation be reversed as Park City did not provide additional services for the tax impact; Park City representatives discussed services that have been or are available to residents since the annexation
- After much discussion, Commissioners voted 3-2 that Park City did not provide services according to the plan.

Planning Department:

- Commissioners approved the MAPC recommendation for zone change to Industrial Park-Airport, between McConnell AFB and Clifton/Rock Road. (5-0)

Aging:

- Commissioners approved a contract for a care assessor to provide services for individuals who are seeking nursing home placement (full reimbursement from Kansas Department on Aging) (5-0)

Department of Corrections:

- Application to Kansas Department of Corrections for unexpended FY2007 funds (\$55,294 requested to replace 44 outdated computer workstations in the Adult Intensive Supervision Program to handle cases and documentation) (5-0)

Public Works:

- Estimate from Aquila for relocation of lines as part of road project on 119th St. West, between 29th & 53rd Streets, for work to be done by December 15 (\$270,000) (5-0)
