## Appointments

Commissioners approved the resolution reappointing Charles H. Peaster, Sr. (Commissioner Parks' reappointment) to the Sedgwick County Nuisance Appeals Board. (4-0)

- Commissioners approved the Kansas Juvenile Justice Authority (JJA) SFY11 Juvenile Justice Authority (JJA) SFY11 Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) Award. (4-0)
- Commissioners approved the monthly INTRUST Bank Arena Report. (4-0)
- Commissioners approved the resolution designating and classifying certain streets to the township system. (4-0)
