Donation

Commissioners approved the donation of \$1000 Watermark Books Gift Certificate to be used to benefit the youth at the Juvenile Detention Facility of the Sedgwick County Department of Corrections. (5-0)

Appointment

- Commissioners approved the resignation of Lunda Asmani from the Community Housing Services. (4-0)
- Commissioners approved the resolution appointing Irene Hart to the Community Housing Services. (4-0)

Citizen Inquiry

Commissioners approved the request to address the Board of County Commissioners regarding Public Shooting Range at Lake Afton. (5-0)
