Proclamations (5-0)

- Commissioners approved the proclamation declaring March 2010 American Red Cross Month.
- Commissioners approved the proclamation declaring March 7 - 14 Severe Weather Awareness Week.

Presentation (5-0)

Commissioners approved the presentation of Career Development Certificates.

Citizen Inquiry (5-0)

Commissioners approved the request to address the Board of County Commissioners regarding the Peck Improvement District by Vickie Burris.

Planning Department (5-0)

Commissioners approved the amendment to the "Wichita-Sedgwick County Unified Zoning Code" related to entertainment establishments, event center, and teen clubs, residential fence height and minor corrections.

COMCARE (5-0)

Commissioners approved the agreement with the Derby School District for a cooperative arrangement designed to improve the provision of certain school-based mental health services to students at Derby High School.

New Business

- Commissioners approved the lease agreement with Bobbie Belcher for County owned property in Mulvane, KS. (5-0)
- Commissioners approved the lease agreement with Darrell Boger for County owned property in Viola, KS. (5-0)

Board of Bids and Contracts

Commissioners approved the Report of the Board of Bids and Contracts regular meeting on February 25, 2010, except Item 3 (5-0); Item 3 (4-1)

- Automotive Paint Products (Fleet Management) - rejected all bids.
- Additional Courtroom and Chambers in Juvenile Courthouse (Facilities Dept.) - Sauerwein Construction Co., Inc., \$1,107,800.
- Digital Recording System (Emergency Communications) - Voice Products, \$210,786 and establish annual contract pricing for maintenance.
- Road Improvements (Public Works) - Cutler Repaving, Inc., \$1,404,185.02.
- Risk Master Support Agreement (Risk Management) - 5 years, \$101,630.48.
