Planning Department

Commissioners received the Wichita Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (WAMPO) Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) 2035 Presentation. (5-0)

- Commissioners approved the modification to the District Attorney Staffing Table. (5-0)
- Commissioners approved the contract with DCCCA Inc. to provide short-term respite and professional resource family care services. (5-0)
