Sedgwick County Fire District #1 Offers Solid Fuel Safety Seminars

(Sedgwick County, Kansas) – On Saturday, September 27th, the Sedgwick County Fire District #1 will conduct four Solid Fuel Safety Seminars at various locations throughout Sedgwick County as part of Chimney Safety Week, September 28th – October 4th. At each location (listed below), a 20 –30 minute presentation will be followed by a question and answer session related to installation, operation and maintenance of solid fuel appliances including fireplaces, wood stoves, wood pellet stoves, and coal stoves.
