Sedgwick County Health Department Closes Flu Shot Clinic

(Sedgwick County, Kansas) – The Sedgwick County Health Department is out of flu shots. More than 17,000 flu shots were provided this season from the Health Department. Flu shots will no longer be given at the regularly scheduled mobile clinic sites or at the 2716 West Central Clinical Services location.

There are steps each of us can do to stay healthy during flu season:

Clean your hands

Washing your hands often will help protect you from germs. Wash your hands with soap and warm water for 15 to 20 seconds. If soap and water aren't available, then use alcohol-based disposable hand wipes or gel sanitizers.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth

Germs are often spread when a person touches something that is contaminated with germs and then touches his or her eyes, nose, or mouth.

Avoid close contact

Avoid close contact with people who are sick. When you are sick, keep your distance from others to protect them from getting sick too.

Cover your mouth and nose

Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing. It may prevent those around you from getting sick.

Stay home when you are sick

If possible, stay home from work, school, and errands when you are sick. You will help prevent others from catching your illness.
