Sedgwick County Prescription Discount Card – FREE!

(Sedgwick County, Kansas) – Americans are paying more for prescription drugs than ever before. Without prescription coverage, staying healthy can come at a high price. With the Sedgwick County Prescription Discount Card, **free to County residents**, you can save money on many of your prescription purchases!

Any county resident can use this program. Even if you have insurance for prescription drugs, you may still benefit from the discount card, since it may save you money on prescription drugs your existing plan does not cover.

Everyone is eligible!

- No income requirements
- No age requirements
- Unlimited use for the whole family

The Sedgwick County Prescription Discount Card is:

- Valuable. Save an average of 20% off the pharmacy's regular price on all commonly prescribed prescriptions and an average savings of 50% on a 3-month supply of select generics through mail service.
- Easy. There are no claim forms to fill out and no annual fee to pay.
- Convenient. Over 80 participating pharmacies right here in Sedgwick County.

Sedgwick County is able to provide this service because of our association with the National Association of Counties (NACo) and serving as a pilot community for this discount drug program. Since December when the pilot project began in Sedgwick County, over 23,800 cards have been distributed. And, in the past five months, 3,688 prescriptions have been presented, with an average savings of nearly \$8.00 per prescription. This means a savings to Sedgwick County residents of over \$29,000 (or a savings of nearly 17% on prescription drug costs).

“This is a great way for citizens to offset some of their healthcare costs,” said Sedgwick County Commission Chairman Dave Unruh. “We encourage all citizens to take advantage of this great program.”
