Sedgwick County Health Department Reports
Three New Cases of Mumps

(Sedgwick County, Kansas) – The Sedgwick County Health Department is reporting three new cases of mumps today. The three new mumps cases include an 11 year old child, an 18 year old adult, and a 24 year old adult.

As of today, there are a total of 31 confirmed and probable cases of mumps in Sedgwick County.

The Sedgwick County Health Department reminds everyone to practice good hand washing, avoid sharing of drinking cups and eating utensils, and avoid close contact with anyone who has the mumps.

The MMR vaccine is currently available at the Clinical Services location at 2716 W. Central, and an administrative fee is being charged for the MMR vaccine. The administrative fee ranges from \$2.00 to \$14.80. The Clinical Services hours are: 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, and 12:00 – 6:00 p.m. on Thursday.
