FIRE EXTINGUISHER SIMULATOR

(Sedgwick County, Kansas) – Thanks to a \$7,000 grant, the Sedgwick County Fire District #1 will be able to purchase a realistic fire extinguisher simulator to educate the community on fire safety and prevention. The donation is being awarded by IMA of Kansas and Fireman’s Fund Insurance Company.

Executives from IMA of Kansas and Fireman’s Fund will present the grant check to Chief Tim Millspaugh and other Sedgwick County Fire District #1 firefighters, who will demonstrate the training simulator at noon on June 25 at 7750 N. Wild West Drive in Park City.

A fire extinguisher simulator allows the department to effectively train operators to use a fire extinguisher correctly. Digital flames allow compressed air and water to provide a realistic simulation of a fire without the hazards of a real flame. In addition, training can take place at any commercial or residential location.

“The primary function of our program is fire prevention and to teach the correct operation of a fire extinguisher in the event of a fire,” said Fire Chief Tim Millspaugh. “These funds will help purchase a much needed tool to help educate and be proactive in the event of a fire in our community.”
