Health Department H1N1 Vaccine Clinic Hours and Mobile Clinics for Dec. 12 - 19 (Sedgwick County, Kansas) – The Sedgwick County Health Department will hold **mobile clinics on Saturday, December 12, at Towne East and Towne West Squares.** Both mobile clinics will be open from **9 a.m. -12 p.m.**

The Health Department's FREE H1N1 Vaccine Clinic at 4095 E. Harry will be open next week (**December 14 – 19**) during the following hours:

Monday:	2 p.m. – 7 p.m.
Tuesday:	2 p.m. – 7 p.m.
Wednesday:	2 p.m. – 7 p.m.
Thursday:	2 p.m. – 7 p.m.
Friday:	9 a.m. – 2 p.m.
Saturday:	9 a.m. – 2 p.m.

These hours will be maintained unless the vaccine supply runs out.

Anyone older than six months of age is eligible to receive a FREE vaccine in Sedgwick County.
