H1N1 Clinic Thanksgiving Hours and Target Groups

(Sedgwick County, Kansas) – The Sedgwick County Health Department's H1N1 Vaccination Clinic will be open Thanksgiving week (the week of **Monday, November 23**) during the following hours:

Monday: 2 to 7 p.m.
Tuesday: 2 to 7 p.m.
Wednesday: 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.
Thursday: CLOSED FOR THANKSGIVING
Friday: CLOSED FOR THANKSGIVING
Saturday: CLOSED FOR THANKSGIVING

The clinic will reopen on Monday, November 30, at 2 p.m. These hours will be maintained unless the vaccine supply runs out. The clinic is located at 4095 E. Harry in Wichita.

The clinic will serve the following groups:

- Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel
- Pregnant women
- Persons age six months through 24 years
- Household contacts and caregivers of infants younger than six months of age
- People age 25 through 64 years who have chronic medical conditions or compromised immune systems

The Health Department will also offer vaccine at three mobile clinics during the week of November 23. These clinics are:

- **Tuesday, Nov. 24:** 9:30-11:30 a.m. – Andale City Building - Board Room, 326 N. Main
- **Tuesday, Nov. 24:** 1:30-4:00 p.m. – Colwich City Hall, 310 S. 2nd St.
- **Wednesday Nov. 25:** 9:30 – 11:30 – Kechi Community Center, 220 W. Kechi Road

Individuals with flu-like symptoms should not come to the vaccine clinic. People exhibiting flu-like symptoms (fever greater than 100 degrees, coughing, respiratory congestion or body aches) will be screened out, as you are not able to receive vaccine if you currently have the flu. Aside from being turned away, individuals who have flu-like symptoms run the risk of infecting others with the flu.

Sedgwick County Health Department has set up a call center to give up-to-date information about H1N1, the clinic and priority groups. Individuals with questions can call 660-5558 or e-mail flu@sedgwick.gov.
